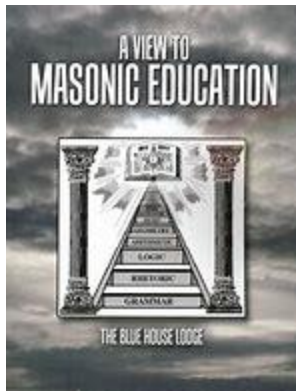

Being Scottish Rite Masons we are all familiar with the *yud* (י). You know, that tiny little Hebrew symbol found inside the equilateral triangle located on our 14th Degree ring. Did you know this smallest of Hebrew letters, barely more than a dot, could change your life? It is the *yud* that begins the most sacred of Hebrew words, i.e., the Name of God, YHVH. Also of note, the land of God, *Israel*, ישראל, begins with the *yud*. The City of God, *Jerusalem*, ירושל, begins with the *yud*. And, as you might expect, the name *Jesus*, in Hebrew, begins with the *yud*. So, what does all this mean in the grand scheme of things? The greatest of words begins with the smallest of letters. In much the same way, the greatest works of God

begin with the smallest strokes. Life itself begins on a scale so small it cannot even be seen. Such is the secret of the *yud*. How then do we apply this idea to our everyday life? As you know, we are all faced from time to time with changes and new ideas. However, by nature we avoid both changes and newness. So, how do we change? He received his 32° on October 21, 1967 and was invested with the Knight Commander Court of Honour on October 5, 2013. Tom was one of the most active 90 year olds that I have known. He was an asset to the Valley of Augusta from the first day he affiliated from Knoxville Tennessee on August 12, 2009. He was instrumental in forming the Augusta Chapter of the Knights of Saint Andrew as well as writing and organizing the 29th degree which we routinely confer in all of the reunions since its inception. He loved to learn, he loved to teach, he loved Masonry and most of all he loved his brethren. The Valley of Augusta named the Educator of the Year Award after him last year. It is now known as the Thomas G. England Educator of the Year Award. Tom was a member of my lodge, (Webb #166) and he was just as active and excited about Masonic Education as he was at the Scottish Rite. Tom was my brother, Tom was my friend, Tom was "ONE OF THE FAITHFUL FEW," and I will miss him.
