

SeaGuardian Terms & Conditions

1. Introduction

These Terms & Conditions ("Terms") govern your access to and use of SeaGuardian services, platforms, applications, devices, and related systems (collectively, the "Services").

By accessing or using the Services, you agree to be bound by these Terms.

2. Definitions

- "SeaGuardian" refers to the company providing the Services.

- Disrupt or damage SeaGuardian systems.
- Interfere with maritime monitoring functions.
- Violate any applicable law or regulation.
- Circumvent security protections or access unauthorised areas.

11. Service Availability & Maintenance

SeaGuardian aims to provide continuous service availability but does not guarantee uninterrupted access.

We may suspend or limit access for maintenance, upgrades, or security reasons.

12. Third-Party Services

Some features may rely on third-party providers for analytics, hosting, connectivity, or mapping.

SeaGuardian is not responsible for third-party actions, policies, or service availability.

13. Limitation of Liability

To the maximum extent permitted by law, SeaGuardian is not liable for:
