

- Game Rules -



Number Of Players - 2-4 * Battle Blocks can be played by 2, 3, or 4 people

Object Of Game- The object of Battle Blocks is to be the first player to have their red block reach the middle of the table.

Setup- To set up Battle Blocks, first carry the game board to its desired location. Unfold the legs and stand upright. Next, place the pieces into the starting position. The red line indicates what size of block goes in what location. Each side of the table has one red block and the middle remains empty.

Game Play- On the playing surface there are two colours of blocks. 4 red and 32 black. Each player has one red block that can only be moved by that player. Any black blocks can be moved by any player. Blocks can only be moved lengthwise in one direction. One move can stretch the length of the table but cannot pass through another block.

Battle Blocks is played with each player making a series of 3 strategic moves. Moving a red or a black block counts as a move. Players will take turns (3 moves per turn) until one players red block reaches the middle. That player claims first place.
