

- Game Rules -



Number Of Players - 2-4

* Four In A Row can be played against a single opponent or in teams of two.

Object Of Game-

The object of Four In A Row is to be the first player / team to get 4 of your coloured in a row- Horizontally, vertically or diagonally.

Setup-

Setting up Four In A Row can be achieved by first choosing a suitable area. Next, Join the legs on the main board by connecting the hooks and forcing the legs upward. One disc can be slid into the slot on each leg. This creates a shelf for the remaining discs to rest on. Finally, slide the bottom handle on the main game board to the middle. This will stop discs from exiting the bottom.

Game Play-

Before starting, players decide randomly which of them will be the beginner; moves are made alternatively, one by turn.

Moves entails in placing new disc on the board; discs slide downwards from upper holes, falling down to the last row or piling up on the last disc introduced in the same column. So, in every turn the introduced disc may be placed at most on seven different squares. The winner is the first player who gets a straight line made with four own discs and no gaps between them.
