

- Game Rules -

Hockey Sauce

Number Of Players - 2-4 * Hockey Sauce can be played individually or in teams of 2

Object Of Game - The object of Hockey Sauce is to shoot the puck from your playing surface into the opposing teams net. The first player/team to accumulate 11 points wins.

Game Play - Playing surfaces are to be placed 20' apart from one another, with net openings facing each other. (Distance can be changed to alter game difficulty) Place nets down onto black rubber posts to secure each net to each playing surface. Both players stand beside a net. (If playing in teams, one member of each team at each net.) One at a time, players will shoot 4 pucks towards the net opposite them. To score a point, puck must remain in net.

Point Structure -

- 1 Point - Puck bounces and off another surface before entering the net.
- 3 Points - Puck enters the net without coming into contact with any other surface. (excluding teammates stick)
- Bonus - If playing in pairs, teammate can deflect their partners shot into the net. Same scoring structure applies.
