

# - Game Rules -



**Number Of Players -** 2-4 \* Plinko (**Baseball**) can be played against a single opponent or in teams of 2

**Object Of Game-** The object of Plinko (baseball) is to have the highest number of "runs" at the end of 9 innings. Runs, Innings, and Outs are tracked by placing magnets on screw heads.

**Game Play-** Away team begins game. Pucks are dropped into any of the top openings. Once the puck has stopped moving, its location is scored. Away team continues batting until 3 Outs have been reached. If a puck reaches the bottom of the game board, magnets are placed corresponding bases. (ex. if a Double is achieved, an away magnet is placed on second base.) Home team drops pucks once away team reaches 3 outs. When the home team reaches 3 outs, the next inning begins.

**Scoring-**

Pop Out -	Single Out
Diving Catch-	Single Out
Strikeout -	Single Out
Ground Out-	Single Out
Double Play-	Two Out
Triple Play-	Three Out
Foul Ball-	Re-Drop

Note\* Runners on base can only be forced around bases
