- Game Rules -



Number Of Players - 2-4 * Plinko (Baseball) can be played against a single opponent or in teams of 2

Object Of GameThe object of Plinko (baseball) is to have the highest number of "runs" at the end of 9 innings. Runs, Innings, and Outs are tracked by placing magnets on screw heads.

Game Play-

Away team begins game. Pucks are dropped into any of the top openings. Once the puck has stopped moving, Its location is scored. Away team continues batting until 3 Outs have been reached. If a puck reaches the bottom of the game board, magnets are placed corresponding bases. (ex. if a Double is achieved, an away magnet is placed on second base.) Home team drops pucks once away team reaches 3 outs. When the home team reaches 3 outs, the next inning begins.
