## - Game Rules - Plunger Toss

Number Of Players - 2-4

\* Plunger Toss can be played against a single opponent, or in teams of two.

**Object Of Game-**

The object of Plunger Toss is to be the first player / team to accumulate 11 points (singles) or 21 points (teams)

Setup-

Setting up Plunger Toss can be achieved by placing the game boards in a open and safe location. Keep game away from people, vehicles and breakable items. Throwing distance can be adjusted to accommodate players skill levels. Leave approximately 20 feet (six paces) between game boards. NOTE: Both players / teams throw towards the <a href="mailto:same">same</a> game board. Teams of 1 throw towards a single game board. Teams of 2 use second game board and partners stand at opposing ends.

Game Play-

Players alternate turns, tossing one plunger towards the game board. Points are scored by touching The **rubber portion** of the plunger to a scoring location.

Scoring locations are as follows:

Plungers resting horizontally on the outer ring, score 1 point. (counted at end of round)
Plungers resting horizontally on the inner ring score 3 points. (counted at end of round)
Plungers resting vertically on the outer ring score 5 points. (counted immediately and removed)
Plungers resting vertically on the inner ring score 10 points. (counted immediately and removed)

NOTE: Rubber portion of plungers touching the game board score as "on the board" Rubber portion of plungers touching black inner ring score as "outer ring"

Horizontal plunger points are are counted once all plungers have been thrown, Vertical plunger points are counted immediately. **NOTE: Resting vertical plungers are <u>removed</u> from game board. Only <u>one</u> team shall score per round.** 

Example: Red Team = 7 points

Black Team = 3 points

= Black team scores 4 points that round
