

- Game Rules - *Square* *ff*

Number Of Players - 2-4 * Square Off can be played against 1,2 or 3 opponents

Object Of Game- The object of Square Off is to make a square with the wooden sticks and claim that square with a coloured puck. The player with the most pucks on the playing surface at the end of the game, wins!

Setup- To set up Square Off, first carry the game board to its desired location. Unfold the legs and stand upright. Next, place the pieces into the starting position. Black sticks into lower, large trough. Coloured pucks into upper, small trough. Each player chooses their puck colour. (Red, White, Black or Blue)

Game Play- Square Off is played with each player taking a turn placing a single black stick, into a grooved slot on the playing surface. Players will continue placing sticks one at a time into the groves until a player completes the forth side of a square. That player gets to claim that square with their coloured puck. **NOTE: The player who completes a square gets the next move.** Once the playing surface has been filled and all the squares have been claimed, the pucks are counted. The player with the most, wins!
