

Number Of Players -

* Volley Pong can be played against a single opponent or in teams of two.

Object Of Game-

The object of Volley Pong is to eliminate all the opposing teams buckets by throwing a volleyball into them.

Setup-

Setting up Volley Pong can be achieved by each team placing 6 buckets into a triangle shape. Each triangle of 6 buckets shall point at each other and be placed approximately 20 feet (six paces) apart. Throwing distance can be adjusted to accommodate players skill levels. **Teammates must stand behind their group of bucks while throwing the volleyball.**

Game Play-

Each team will attempt to throw the 2 volleyballs into the opposing teams buckets. If this occurs, the bucket holding the volleyball is removed from gameplay, after both balls have been thrown. If both volleyballs land in the same bucket, two buckets shall be removed and the scoring team is rewarded with another turn of two shots. Volleyballs in flight shall not be interfered with in anyway. Once balls have landed, they can be handled. Teams alternate taking 2 shots until all of one teams buckets have been removed. The team with remaining buckets wins.
