How to Clean Ears

1.BE PREPARED

GET COTTON WOOL, EAR BUDS, CLEANER AND TREATS READY. WEAR GLOVES.





2. FILL THE EAR
WITH CLEANER.
LIFT THE OUTER EAR UP
VERTICALLY, BE GENTLE.

3.MASSAGE CLEANER.

KEEP THE OUTER EAR
LIFTED, USE CIRCULAR
MOTIONS, HEAR THE
SQUELCH! 20 SECONDS.





4. ALLOW DOG TO
SHAKE THEIR HEAD.
HELPS TO CLEAR LIQUID
AND MOBILISE THE WAX.

5. CLEAN EAR OUT.

WIPE THE SKIN FOLDS
WITH COTTON WOOL AND
ENSURE IT IS LEFT DRY.





6. REPEAT THE PROCESS IF REQUIRED. THEN CHANGE TO OTHER EAR.

How to Clean Teeth

1.BE PREPARED

TOOTHBRUSH,
FINGERBRUSH OR DENTAL
WIPES, TOOTHPASTE AND
TREATS. NO HUMAN
TOOTHPASTE PLEASE.







2. CLEAN INCISORS.

TINY TEETH, TOP AND
BOTTOM, INCLUDING
THE GUMS.

3.CLEAN CANINES.

"FANG" TEETH IN CORNERS.
THESE OFTEN HAVE A
LARGE BUILD UP OF DENTAL
CALCULUS.





4. CLEAN MOLARS.

LARGE TEETH AT THE

BACK. CHECK ALL TEETH

ARE HEALTHY.

5. CHECK ALL THE TEETH AGAIN.

ALWAYS GIVE A HIGH VALUE REWARD WHEN COMPLETE.






6. REPEAT PROCESS AS OFTEN AS POSSIBLE, DAILY IS BEST. THIS IMPROVES OVERALL HEALTH AND SAVES YOU \$\$\$ ON VETERINARY DENTAL WORK.

How to Trim Nails

1.BE PREPARED

Clippers-correct size, good natural light, treats. Two people is ideal, one to hold, one to cut. Take your time, give frequent high rewards.







2. UNDERSTAND THE ANATOMY.

Be careful to avoid the quick or it will bleed and hurt your dog.

3.NEVER ANGLE CLIPPERS VERTICALLY. Hold them parallel to the base of the pad.






4. A 45 DEGREE ANGLE IS BEST.

Clip a little at a time, go slowly to avoid injury.

5. REMEMBER THE DEWCLAW.

This is often the longest and sharpest nail.





6. REPEAT THE PROCESS AS OFTEN AS REQUIRED. THIS WILL PREVENT NAIL INJURY AND SCRATCHING.
