The information in this guide was collected with the assistance of our Developmental Disabilities Regional Offices (DDRO) staff. This guide is intended as a directory of assessment services. This is not an exclusive list of testing and assessment services nor does inclusion on the list indicate OPWDD approval or endorsement of the provider.

OPWDD expects providers to conduct diagnostic evaluations and assessments in accordance with accepted professional standards and follow appropriate manualized procedures when administering and interpreting specific assessment tools. Failure to adhere to such standards requires OPWDD to question the validity of the assessment results. For more information on these standards, please refer to the reference documents listed in the 2001 Guidelines, and to the additional documents found on the OPWDD eligibility webpage at: <https://opwdd.ny.gov/eligibility>

Depending on the complexity of an individual's condition, and the date of any prior evaluations, the process for obtaining an OPWDD services eligibility determination could require multiple or specialty assessments that are done by providers not listed in this Guide. We recommend that you work with the Eligibility Coordinator at your local DDRO to ensure that you have submitted a complete eligibility packet when requesting an eligibility determination.

We hope this guide is a valuable resource that assists you in obtaining the services you need. We strive to maintain the accuracy of the information provided, and intend to update this guide on a regular basis.
