ALL FAMILY MEMBERS ARE WELCOME TO JOIN. CUB SCOUTING IS A FAMILY AFFAIR.

Pack DUES are \$180 for scouts, paid to Pack 151. BSA Dues are \$80/returning scout and \$105/new scout. Paid to the BSA.

PAPERWORK NEEDED:

- Youth Application with payment
- Youth Protection Certificate from the Online Adult Training
- Medical AB for the Scout

You will need to go to the Scout Store to purchase the uniform. This will be your Class A uniform.



Youth Protection Training (YPT)

1. Go to <https://my.scouting.org> and create an account for you and a separate one for your spouse (**not your child**).
2. Once logged in, click on the Youth Protection Training symbol.
3. Scroll down past the video and Add Plan. Once added do all 4 courses.
4. After completion, return to my.scouting.org, select Menu then MyDashboard. Click on the printer icon, and download the Youth Protection Training Certificate.
5. Email the certificate to your Cub Master or bring to your next meeting.

WHAT DOES TWO RAISED FINGERS MEAN IN CUB SCOUTS?

The two raised fingers stand for the Scout Oath and the Scout Law. The fingers look like the sharp ears of the wolf ready to listen to Akela. The Cub Scout sign should be given when repeating the Cub Scout Promise or Law of the Pack. It is also used in ceremonies.

This will also be used to get all scouts attention. When you see this sign from a leader it will mean to remain still and quiet.
