



# ADD Powr Sorcer Apprentice

**T**he Sorcer Apprentice from Coherence Systems is described as an 'electronic harmonic resonator' device. Developed by Bill Stierhout, the inventor of the Quantum Resonant Technology (QRT) system used by Nordost, the Sorcer Apprentice aims to saturate the power supplies of components with harmonic frequencies, thereby increasing the energy of the audio material. By injecting low-frequency square waves into component power supplies based on Fourier's series and harmonic resonance, the Sorcer Apprentice claims to boost the system's signal-to-noise ratio.

Stierhout believes that the Sorcer Apprentice can provide an energy boost of 10-15% to the audio signal level and an acoustic energy increase of 0.25-1.00dB. The device features four line transformers and an EMI line filter, with two outputs for the system.

The device takes some time to integrate into the system, but the improvements are significant, with clearer music, a more focused soundstage, and a realistic listening experience. Interestingly, users have reported a deeper effect on the listener, creating a sense of relaxation and musical enjoyment that may be attributed to a change in brainwave state from Beta to Alpha. Despite the lack of logical explanation for this effect, the Sorcer Apprentice consistently enhances the overall sound quality of the system at this deeper 'chillax' level.

In our review, Alan Sircom states, "It's hard not to be impressed by the ADD Powr Sorcer Apprentice, even if the reasons why it is so impressive are not the stuff of normal audio observations. It makes a good system into an exceptional one."
