Jeff Hrubes provided an overview of plan administration. The two options are to form a Joint Powers Entity or a Joint Powers Collaboration. The advantage of a Joint Powers Entity is that it has decision making authority while a Joint Powers Collaboration requires approval by all participating boards. However, a Joint Powers Entity does form an additional layer of government and would have expenses associated with it. The Policy Committee has until the 60-day comment period (June) to decide how to administer the plan. In addition, a Joint Powers Collaboration can be changed to a Joint Powers Entity in the future if needed. It was recommended that each County Attorney be consulted before a decision is made.

Melanie Bomier provided an overview of the goals recommended by the Advisory Committee.

# M/S to approve the goals list as presented Telker/Ludwig

Melanie Bomier provided an overview of the ordinance comparison of Carlton and Pines Counties. The main difference highlighted was that Pine County has a countywide point of sale inspection requirement while Carlton County only has a point of sale inspection requirement 300 feet from rivers/streams and 1000 feet from lakes.

Next meeting is planned for Thursday May 7<sup>th</sup> 9:00 to 11:00 and will likely be web meeting. This meeting will present/seek approval for the watershed actions and further discuss plan administration.
