Melanie Bomier presented the Plan Administration document. The following decisions were made:

- 1. <u>Work Agreements between LGU Options</u>: Work will be completed by LGUs, and a reimbursement request will be sent to the Fiscal Agent, along with required paperwork. Requests for up-front funding can be made to the Policy Committee if needed.
- Landowner Contracts (for Ag BMPs): The Fiscal Agent must approve landowner contracts, along with technical and administrative sign offs according to the LGU's policies before payment is made to the landowner.
- 3. <u>The Watershed Based Implementation Fund Grant Cost Share Rate Options (Ag BMPs and Forest</u> <u>Management Plans)</u>: Cost share rate of 75% and up to 90% of project cost in high-priority, targeted areas. High-priority, targeted areas will be identified using the plan data, and presented/approved at the next Policy Committee meeting.
- 4. <u>LGUs and Grant Applications within the watershed</u>: Allow LGUs to apply for grants (other than Watershed Based Implementation Funds) to complete projects listed in the plan as needed and appropriate.
- 5. <u>Policy Committee Meeting Schedule</u>: The Policy Committee will meet Biannually. Early September will be for field visits & to decide any changes needed for the upcoming year's policies. March meeting for

planning the upcoming year. Other meetings will be scheduled as needed, and quarterly email updates will be sent to the Policy Committee.
