

MONTHLY MISSION

The monthly mission in February will benefit The Beacon in York, PA. The Beacon is a day center that provides the unhoused with hydration, restrooms, classes, mail services, and necessities and connections to community resources. They serve between 120 and 150 persons each day.

GENERAL FUND

During the month of March, the Finance Committee is requesting everyone give to the General Fund versus the mortgage. Currently, we're very healthy with the state of the interest free mortgage nearly paying down \$100,000.00 in the first 10 months of the loan. We need to build up the General Fund so that we are in better position to conduct the day to day operations of the church. This is just for the month of March.

ADULT HELP NEEDED


