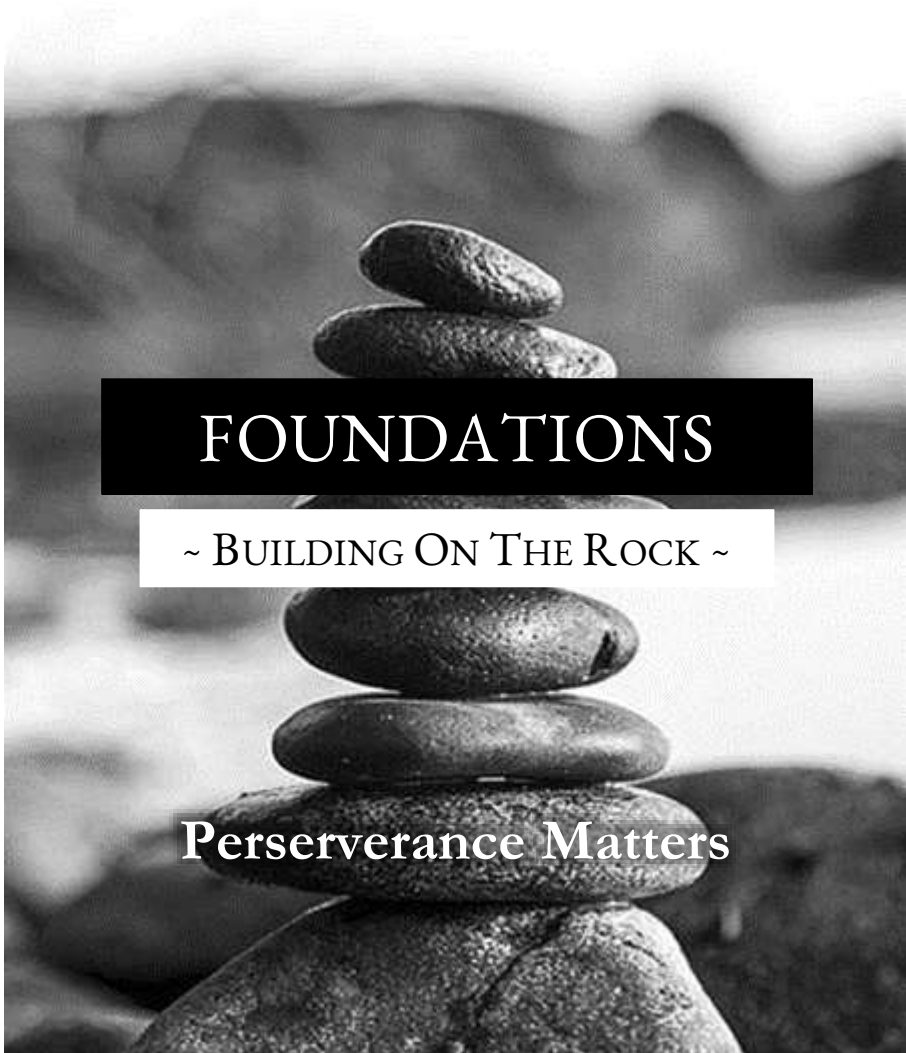

HELP PAY OFF THE DEBT

RAISERIGHT

One of the easiest ways you can help support the debt reduction efforts at Emmanuel is to participate in the RaiseRight program.

What is RaiseRight?

RaiseRight is a fundraising program that allows individuals and families to raise money for organizations by purchasing gift cards. RaiseRight connects fundraisers with retailers and brands, and offers a variety of gift card options, including eGift cards, physical gift cards, and reloadable gift cards. Each brand gifts back a percentage of the total purchase back to the organization. An example is Giant Food Stores giving back 3.5%, Sheetz at 3%, and Outback Steakhouse at 10%.

Between August 25, 2024 and August 18, 2026:

Total Amount of Gift Cards Purchased – **\$84,635.00**

Total Amount Retained/Earned for EEUMC – **\$3,603.94**

Average Percentage back to EEUMC – **4.2%**

If your preferred store doesn't have a physical gift card, they most likely have an e-card and/or the option to print a paper copy/email copy with a bar code.

An updated list of RaiseRight brands is available in the lobby or you can contact the church office to have it emailed to you.

If you place your order in the offering plate or order online by noon on Monday, they will be available the next Sunday.
