 through participation.
- Continue to hold children and young people with SEND, firmly at the heart of everything we do- ensuring we provide a service that reflects local need.
- Ensure we are there to support children who are looked after, and make their carers aware of IAS, so that we may offer support to them too.
- Continue to roll out our training offer to upskill and build confidence in parents and carers, and provide advocacy for children and young people with SEND, to ensure all their voices are heard, and enable them to take control of their own situations, as empowered individuals.
- Help support those who are living in poverty/ at risk of loosing their financial means by providing advice and signposting to those that can help. We will continue to support those families whose children are not attending school, to get them back into education, allowing families to get back to work/ sustain their employment

In addition to these principles, IAS as a service can;

- Be a responsible recycler
- Use Bolton services wherever possible for consumables, training and business needs
- Employ local people, keeping the Bolton pound in Bolton
- Remain community based- sitting within the CVS building in our town centre
- Continue to work with, support, and signpost to, other community organisations and charities for children with SEND in Bolton
