Exclusion review- what Bolton must do better....

We are working with the Local Authority to look at exclusions from school in the borough. IAS have linked up with Little Lever High school, Leverhulme primary school, the children with disabilities team, families information service, Behaviour support and Bolton council inclusion team, to do some research into how exclusions happen in Bolton and the impact on families. This will feed into the council's priority work, and will hopefully bring about a set of recommendations to improve the process for young people affected by exclusion from
