Proposals for posters and papers (12 minutes spoken presentation, 3 minutes for questions) are encouraged. All proposals must include a 50-word synopsis to be included in the online program as well as additional information/materials as outlined on the website. Proposals (abstracts & information sheet for Proposal) are to be submitted to Dr. Jaclyn Maass via email at oklahomaps.org@gmail.com

Notification of acceptance will be sent to the email address provided on the registration form on or before **April 14, 2021.** If you want your paper to be considered for an award, then you need to submit (attach to email), in addition to the above materials, a 15 paged, APA-style paper. If you would like for your poster to be considered for an award then you need to submit, in addition to the above materials, a 750-word synopsis. We encourage the submission of proposals for posters and papers. For award consideration, the project must demonstrate that data has been collected. All poster presenters must submit a link to a personal web conference room (e.g., Zoom, WebEx, Microsoft Teams, etc.) for the presenter to host during the poster session. All posters must be emailed as a .jpg or .pdf by April 21, 2021 in order to be included in the program.
