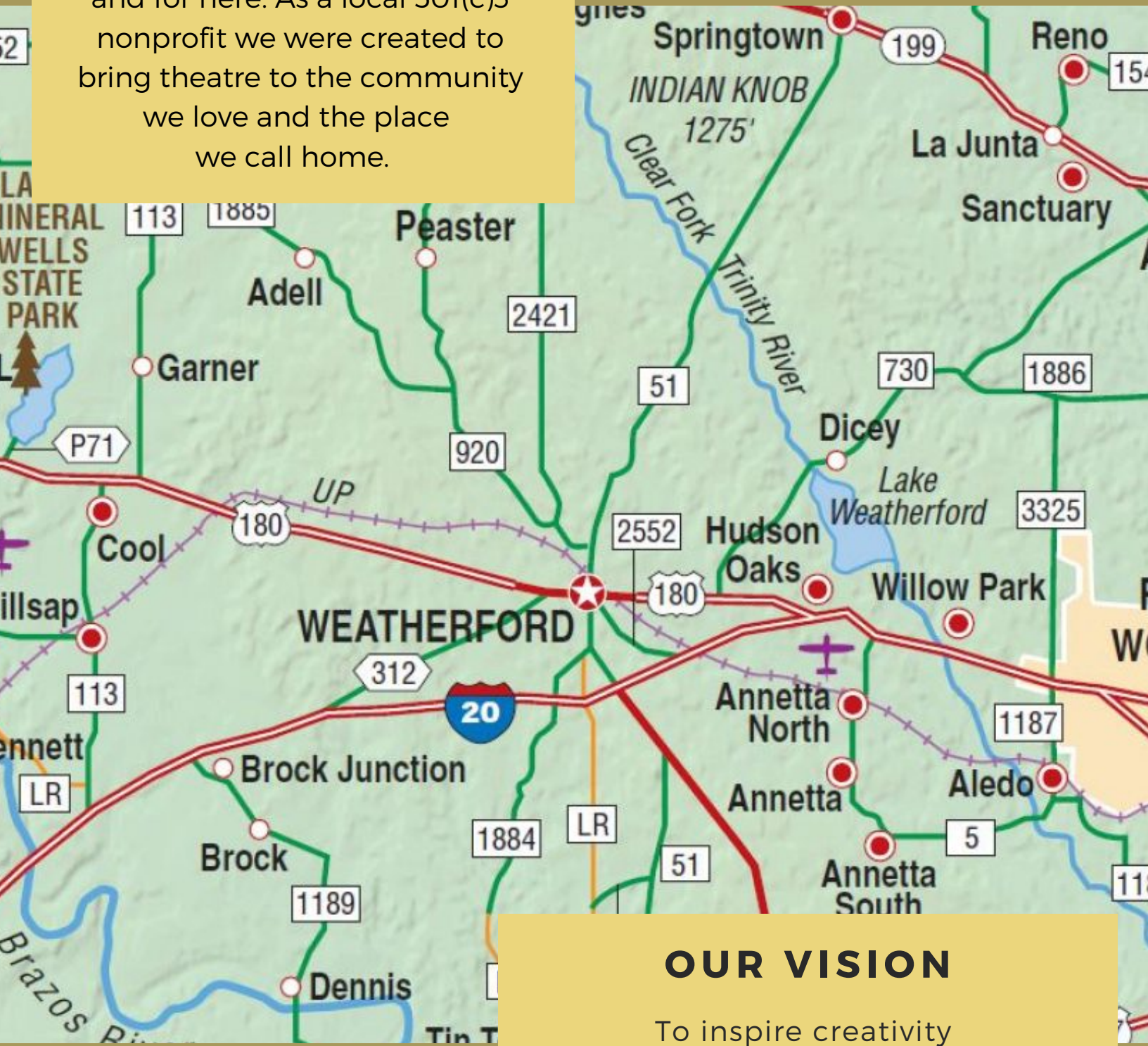

## OLIVIA DICKERSON

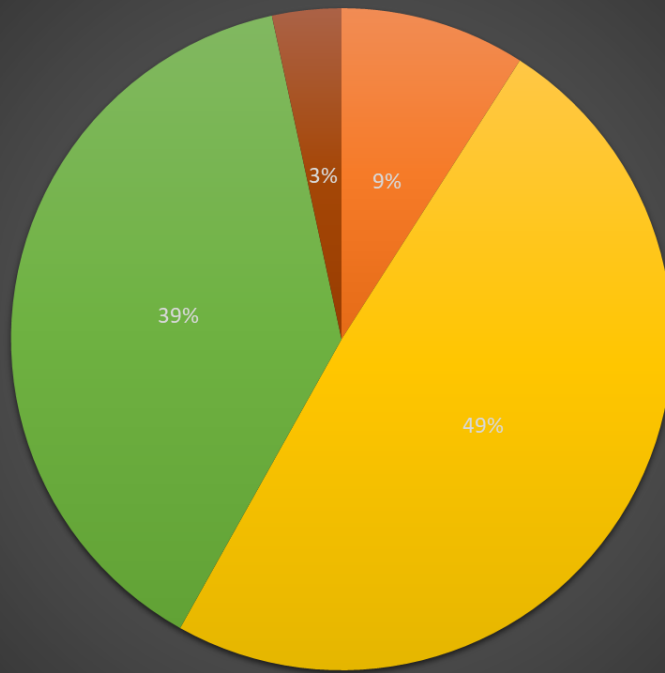
### ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTOR

## 2022 INCOME \$10,916.62



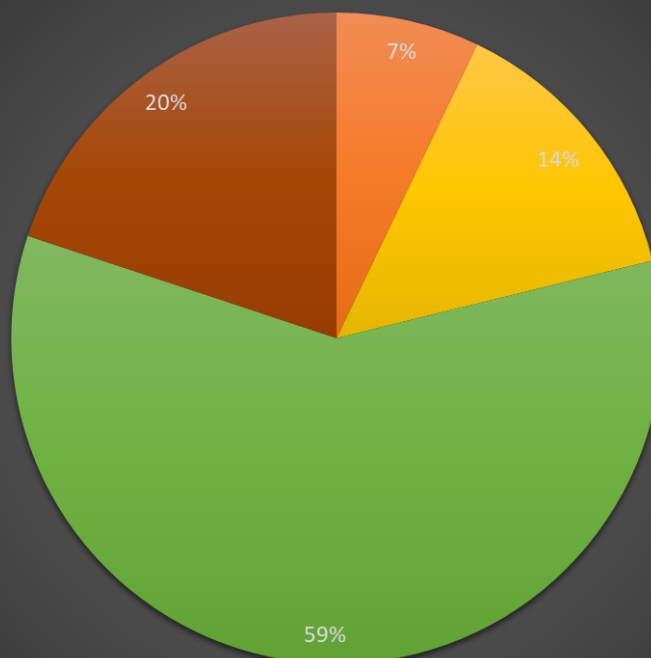
Productions Donations Fundraisers Misc.

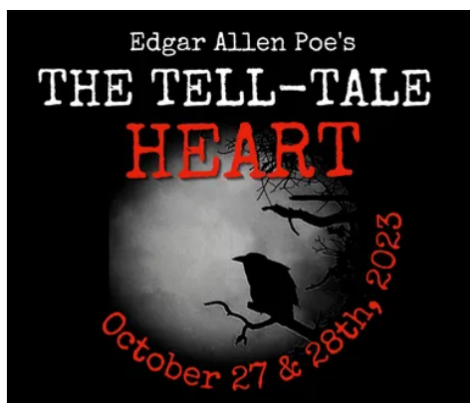

Bring your favorite picnic blanket or lawn chair and join us for a unique retelling of this classic tale. Come see what is lurking in the shadows this Fall!

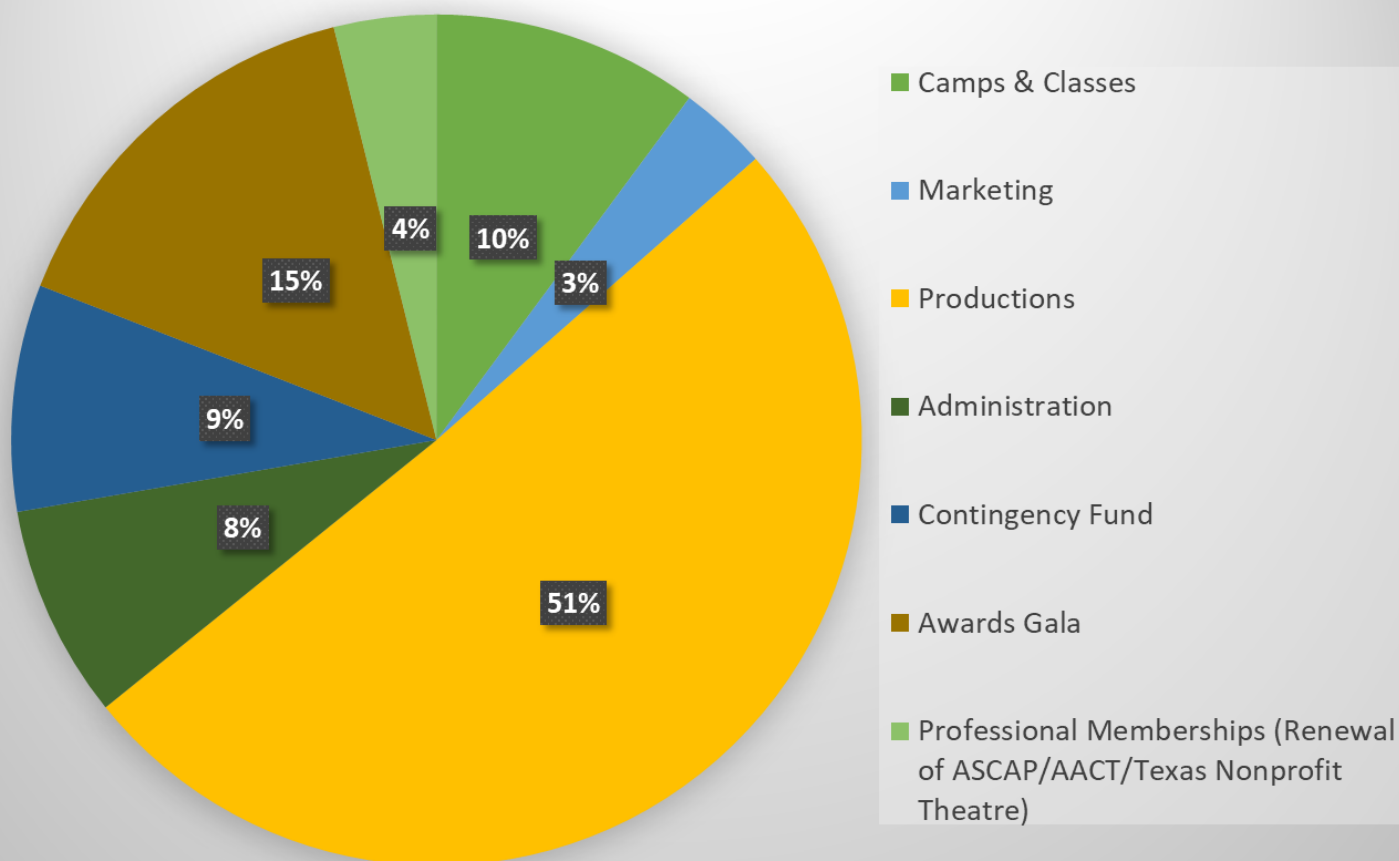

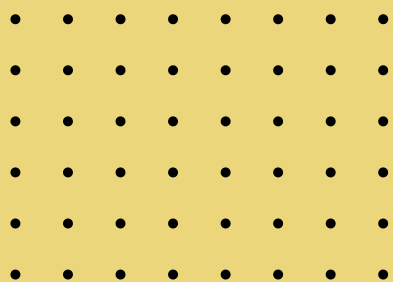
