Installing the All Balls Air Cut Valve O-rings

INSTALLING THE All Balls Air Cut Valve (ACV) O-Rings:

The All Balls ACV jet O-rings are a bit fatter than stock and are more difficult to install. Here is how to install them:


Items Needed:

- Super Lube Silicone Oil for O-ring lubrication
- ACV O-rings from the All Balls Kit
- JIS screwdriver

Procedure

- 1. Lubricate the O-rings with Super Lube Multi-Purpose Synthetic Oil.
- 2. Install the 2 jet O-rings on the ACV brass 120 jet.
- 3. Install the nose O-ring on the ACV.
- 4. Apply a small amount of lube to the brass vacuum tube on the carb.
- 5. Apply a small amount of lube to the ACV vacuum input tube.
- 6. Connect the rubber vacuum tube to the carb but leave it disconnected from the ACV.
- 7. Set the captured O-ring end of the jet onto the jet port on the carb body.







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8. Place the tip of the JIS screwdriver on the brass jet and apply a circular motion while pressing down to get the jet seated in the bottom of the hole.



- 9. Set the ACV in place and move it around a bit to seat it.
- 10. Verify the nose O-ring is not sticking out.
- 11. Hold the ACV up straight so the screw doesn't try to cross thread.
- 12. Start the screw, then tighten it while seating the ACV.
- 13. Install the vacuum tube on the ACV.
