Carburetor Refurb Turnaround time and My Process for Refurbishing Carbs

For carbs, I have clients ship their carbs to me. I refurbish them and balance and tune them on my test engine. Then I ship them back ready to install and ride.

Turnaround time is 1 week from the start date. I start on Monday, and ship on Friday or Saturday.

CARB REBUILD:

Typical uploads include:

- 2. Initial inspection report (see attached copy of blank report.)
- 3. Carbs disassembled and ready for ultrasonic cleaning.
- 4. Carbs after cleaning laid out to dry.
- 5. Carbs ready for assembly.
- 6. Assembled carb bank ready for test engine for balancing and tuning.
- 7. Video of tuned and balanced carbs running on test engine.
- 8. A video explaining the use of the Digi Sync carb balance tool on the test engine.
- 9. Final carb inspection report
- 10. Any other pictures or information needed.

Information I need for tuning your carbs.

- Bike model (Standard, Tourer, Interstate)
- o Type of Air Filter (Stock, or K&N or other high flow filter) Stock is recommended.
- Type of exhaust (Stock or aftermarket)
- If exhaust is stock, has it been modified. If yes, how was it modified? (Piggies cut, Baffles drilled, Baffles cut out.)
- o If aftermarket, what brand?
- o Are baffles in or out?

Exhaust mods that lower the back pressure significantly will require different jetting than stock. The additional jets will cost about \$85 including Shipping, depending on the market at the time.

If I find broken or missing parts that require replacing, I can source new parts for you or sell you used parts for $\frac{1}{2}$ price IF I have them.
