Darcel had a fantastic athletic career, starting at NRHS, with a NYS record in the 880 yard relay. She was selected as a High School All-American and “Athlete of the Year” in Prep Track and Field. She also was successful at the club level, establishing herself as an AAU All-American at the 220 yard distance. She was the Section 1 Champion and a member of the All-County team. Darcel was selected to be on the All-Divisional Team of the Westchester-Putnam Conference in recognition of her achievements in the 220 and 880 relay. She received the Marie V. Farrar Scholarship Award from the Young Women’s League of New Rochelle. Darcel went on to run and play basketball in college, continuing to win post season recognition and awards.



Clyde Vaughan

Clyde had a very successful basketball career. Starting at NRHS he was a Con Edison Award winner, selected to All-County, All-State and All-American teams. He also led NYS in scoring with 35 points per game. Vaughan played for the University of Pittsburgh, leading the team in scoring and rebounding in his final three seasons. He also led the Big East in scoring twice and his career point total is second all-time. Clyde went onto a pro career in Europe, where he continued to his scoring prowess, leading the European League in scoring four times. Vaughan then became a coach at various schools, including South Florida, Long Beach State and Connecticut. He has been elected to the Westchester County Sports Hall of Fame and their All-Century Team. His No. 40 jersey is retired at NRHS.
