She was NYS Champion and record holder, Loucks Games Champion and record holder, Big 10 Indoor Champion, and earned 21 All-American titles. Dwyer ran in the Penn Relays, the World Championships and the Olympic Games.

Rich was a three sport star at NRHS, as captain of the football and baseball teams, and as an outstanding wrestler who placed second at the NYS Sectionals.
