The Alberta Federation of Shooting Sports is currently accepting applications from Shooting Sports Associations to join the AFSS community.

Why Join the Alberta Federation of Shooting Sports:

Benefits of joining the AFSS:

1. Access to Exclusive Programs

- Scholarships
 - The members of a new association that meet the scholarship qualifications may apply for an Alberta Federation of Shooting Sports scholarship once their association has been a member for a full year.
- Grants
 - New associations become eligible to apply for grant funding after maintaining AFSS membership for one full year. For example, an association that joins in August 2026 may apply by the December 1, 2027, deadline, provided its affiliation fees are in good standing.
- Casino Spending
 - New associations may apply for casino funding in the year after the association provides volunteers for a casino. For example, an association that supplies volunteers for a 2027 casino may apply for casino funding in 2028.

2. Networking Opportunities

- Opportunity to network with other associations at Board Meetings, Annual General Meeting, and any events that the AFSS may host.

3. Recognition and Creditability

- Part of the larger shooting community in Alberta.
- The Government of Alberta's Chief Firearms Office recognizes the Alberta Federation of Shooting Sports as a trusted organization with the integrity and expertise to support the future of shooting sports.
- AFSS refers interested individuals to affiliated associations.

4. Discounts on Courses

- Affiliated associations receive a discount on any courses the association schedules.

5. Feature Page on AFSS's Website

- Affiliated associations receive their own dedicated page on the AFSS's website, with links to the association's own website and upcoming events.

Affiliation Fees:

How to Apply:

Complete the application form and return with the required documentation.

- Copy of registration with Alberta Societies and/or proof of filing with Alberta Corporate Registries
- List of current year board of directors with contact information
- Current membership list – must include name, sex, location (John Smith, M, Edmonton). Include member's date of birth if known.
- Last year's reviewed/audited financial records. Only exception is new associations as indicated on the association's corporate documents.
- Summary of associations activities:
 - Type of shooting
 - Events held
 - Leagues

Once your application is approved an invoice for the affiliation fees will be emailed to the association treasurer.
