

## Campbelltown Collegians Football Club Spectator Code of Conduct

We all bear a collective responsibility to set a good example and help provide a positive environment in which all players can learn and enjoy the game. Play your part by observing and respecting this Code of Conduct for fellow spectators, players, referees, parents and officials at all times.

- 1. Remember that we play for FUN.
- 2. Applaud effort and good play as well as success.
- 3. Respect the referee's decisions even when you don't agree with them.
- 4. Appreciate good play from whichever team it comes from.
- 5. Remain behind the sideline and within the designated Spectator's area.
- 6. Let the coach do their job and do not confuse the players by telling them what to do.
- 7. Encourage the players to respect their opposition, referee and match officials.
- 8. Support positively and offer players encouragement rather than criticism.
- 9. Never engage in or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour.

If the code is not followed, any/all of the following actions may be taken:

## YOU MAY BE:

- 1. Issued with a verbal warning from a club official.
- 2. Required to meet with the club committee.
- 3. Ordered to leave the match venue by the club.
- 4. Requested by the club not to attend future games.
- 5. Suspended or have your/your child's club membership terminated.

## OTHER IMPORTANT NOTES:

1 As we run on volunteers, parents, grandparents or other spectators will be asked to assist with canteen/BBQ duties. This will NOT be every week.

2 As you will all have your own team group; your coach or manager will notify you if your team is rostered on volunteer duty for that weekend.

3 If your team is rostered on only ONE parent from that team will be required for half an hour BEFORE your game. All volunteers will be out of the canteen in time to watch their family play.

4 For home games only - if your team has a 9.00am game they will be responsible to set up the field - so please be here by 8.30am to help each other.

5 For home games only - if your team is last to play on any field you will have to pack up the field. This includes packing away nets, corner posts and bins on that field and bringing them back up to the club house.

6 Please be aware that coaches and managers are NOT required to do canteen duties or set up and pack down the fields, they already have enough to do.

7 No person's contact details are to be given out to anyone without that person's consent.

8 Our social media policy states that anyone involved with the Campbelltown Collegians Football Club that is found to be THREATENING, BULLYING, HARASSING or STALKING anyone involved within the club, a referee or an official will be reported to the POLICE immediately.
