**The teacher will be responsible for establishing and maintaining a classroom environment that utilizes space, materials, routines, and guidance techniques to effectively facilitate physical, emotional, intellectual and social development of the children. Native (or fluent) proficiency in French is mandatory.**

### **Essential duties and responsibilities:**

- Plan and implement activities to meet the physical, emotional, intellectual and social needs of the children in the program
- Provide various experiences and activities for children including songs, games and storytelling
- Develop activities that introduce math and literacy concepts
- Supervision and responsibilities for children during recess, snack, lunch and nap time
- Implement positive discipline when required
- Attend professional development trainings
- Willing to obtain Pre-K Director License

- Analyze student assessment data to inform instructional planning
