Cursillo has been pursuing these goals for almost 80 years. The teachings shared during the weekend are to strengthen and equip each person to move forward sharing their own unique gift. Cursillo is now moving around the Diocese from church to church and growing each consecutive time. This is God's doing. He wants us to grow the faithful in our community, church, and diocese. This leads us outward to the whole world and mission work wherever we are called.

Our verse for the weekend is 1 Corinthians 12:4-5. "Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord." In one bible class, I was told to think of our church members as different threads that can be woven together. A thread is strong and has a purpose (to hold a seam in our pants, for one). But imagine how strong the seam would be if you used two together. Now take all the different threads in your church, which have different colors, strengths, and textures, and "weave them together". This blanket of Gifts, freely given by God, is to glorify God, foster growth in our church and community, strengthen others to share their gifts, and grow in our Diocese and state. I see this happening even now.

These gifts from the Holy Spirit must be fed and strengthened (by study). They're not to be stored up or advertised. They are for service to the body of Christ. Our Weekend Saint is St. Vincent de Paul. He is a saint of charity and a volunteer, which I hope represents all of Cursillo. All of us are serving this weekend to train and serve our new Cursilliastas, who are volunteering. We will be at St. Paul's Anglican in Summerville from Oct. 16-19. Our Clausura is Sunday at 2:30 p.m. Please join us to weave these new brothers and sisters into our growing community.
