Saturday of Eagle Fun Days (Saturday or Friday - Monday)	July 13-15
Labor Day	September 2
Patriot Day *Black streamer hung all day	September 11
National POW/MIA Recognition Day	September 20
Veterans Day	November 11
Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day *Black streamer hung all day	December 7

Orville Jackson Post 127 will display and remove the American Flag at your place of business on the holidays noted above (except during inclement weather or possible hanging night before). We ask that you and your employees do not remove the flag. Our members will be fully responsible for its removal and storage. If the flag is stolen, we accept full responsibility of the flag.
