


Welcome to the Family

We are pleased to announce that Session has hired Rev. Dr. Dan Muttart to be our Stated Supply Pastor until such time as the Pastoral Search Committee recommends a permanent pastor. Rev. Dan recently retired after serving for almost 22 years in ordained ministry, 13 of those in the EPC. He was born and raised in Toronto Ontario Canada but emigrated permanently to the United States in 1986, becoming a citizen in 1992. He has served churches in Monroeville, Richland Township, Natrona Heights and Pulaski and has been known for making biblical truths from God's inerrant word real and practical for people's lives.
