	Teach me to be humble and to serve others selflessly

Reflect on a moment when you practiced humility.



Galatians 5:13

My brothers and sisters, you were chosen to be free. But don't use your freedom as an excuse to live under the power of sin. Instead, serve one another in love.

Reflection: How can you serve others in your community?	Prayer: A short prayer related to the theme.
	Lord, show me ways to serve those around me with love

Write about a recent act of service you performed.



DAY 14: **FAITHFULNESS**
