What's happening in 2025?

Clinics: June 21, 2025 (with potentially more to come)

There will be multiple horsemanship clinics hosted throughout the summer months for a range of equine disciplines. Not only will they be a fun experience, but an educational one for all in attendance. They will be instructed by professionals in this field who have experience with every age group.

Barrel Racing (Date TBA) & Gymkhana Jackpots: June 22, and September 20

Barrel racing is an event in which a horse and rider attempt to run a cloverleaf pattern around preset barrels in the fastest time. Gymkhana includes barrel racing and also many other game-like activities that include horse and rider. We plan on hosting multiple events this year at Seager Wheeler, for beginners and seasoned riders and all experience levels in between.

The Homestead Horse Show: July 12, 2025

This will be a grassroots horse show, specifically geared for kids, those new to showing, or for more experienced riders wanting a relaxed show atmosphere. This is an event where new riders can learn from seasoned competitors. This show will help the local horse community to create attainable goals and to work towards achieving those goals with their equine partners.

Many youth classes will be available, as well as walk/trot sessions that are great for beginner riders (of all ages), or horses that aren't ready to compete in the loping classes.

KCRA Rodeo : July 25 - 27, 2025

KCRA Rodeo is coming back to Rosthern in 2025! This is an action packed weekend for the entire family, with . bronc riding, bareback riding , team roping, tie-down roping, break-away roping, steer wrestling, barrel racing, bull riding, mutton busting, refreshment gardens, food trucks, cowboy church, and so much more.

Harvest Festival: September 20, 2025

As of 2024, the Town of Rosthern's Recreation Department is spearheading this event. Not only will the RAS still be involved, but many other local and surrounding non-profit associations and businesses. This day includes activities such as a pancake breakfast, parade, business & artisan market, and so much more, with activities at Seager Wheeler, the Youth Farm and within town limits of Rosthern.

Programming & Workshops: May to October 2025

We will host workshops such as gardening, bread making, food preserving, how to care for animals and mental health. Stay tuned for details!
