Important show info:

- Concession will be available onsite.
- No entries will be accepted after Wednesday, July 10th unless indicated on Facebook.
- In order for registration to be processed, waiver and registration form must be emailed in, as well as payment in full by etransfer to raslighthorse@gmail.com (Password: rosthern)
- No adding classes on the day of show. No refund will be given for scratched classes.
- Placing with ribbons to 5th. Monetary prizes as follows:
 - o 1st \$15.00, 2nd \$12.00, 3rd \$8.00, 4th 5.00
 - o If a class has 3 or less riders, prize payout will be 1st \$8.00, 2nd \$5.00
 - Ranch Trifecta Jackpot will be paid out 100% of entries, at a rate of 1st 40%, 2nd 30%, 3rd 20%, 4th 10%
 - Small Fry and Leadline classes are free with no cash payouts.
- Classes may be split or combined based on the show committee's discretion.
- All riders must be in the holding area and ready to enter the ring before their class.
- All Youth are to wear ASTM/BSI approved helmets whenever they are sitting on their horse at any time during the show day, as well as during in-hand classes. Riders of all ages must wear an approved helmet for English classes.
- Sick horses must stay home if your horse or another horse in your herd is showing any sign of illness, inform the show office prior to 8:00am on show day and your entries will be refunded. Entries will not be refunded for any other reason.
- No Coggins test required.
- The Homestead Horse Show committee, Rosthern Agricultural Society and Seager Wheeler Farm, will not be responsible for any and all loss, liability, damage, or costs due to the participation in The Homestead Horse Show to riders, horses, owners, or spectators.
- Drinking water for horses provided.
- Please pick up manure in the holding area and put in wheelbarrow provided.

Rules Clarifications:

Rules are to follow the Saskatchewan Horse Federation Heritage Circuit Handbook, unless otherwise stated below. This is not a SHF Heritage Circuit Show for 2024.

- **English attire:** we would like to encourage everyone to have a chance to try showing English, therefore we are relaxing the English attire rules. You must have an approved riding helmet with chin strap, but of any colour. You must have a solid coloured long-sleeve shirt (hunt coat optional), with breeches or riding tights, and riding boots or half chaps.
- Youth bit rule: our goal is for all riders to work up to riding their older horse in a shank bit and one-handed. However, for the safety of beginner youth who are just learning (whether in regular classes or walk-trot), we will allow the option of all youth to ride in a snaffle with two hands regardless of their horses' age. Any youth riding their horse in a shank bit must still ride one handed.
- Walk/trot classes: we want riders or horses of any ability to feel comfortable
 participating in our show. So, for our show, the walk/trot classes are for riders of all
 levels and horses of all ages that are currently unable to show at a lope. No cross entry
 between Walk/Trot classes and other classes, with the exception of Halter and
 Showmanship.
- Age categories: riders must compete in their Age Division as determined by the Year of Birth as it appears on their Birth Certificate. Any age may compete in Open classes.

Parking:

• Trailer tying only. No electricity, pens or barns available at this time. If you want to park on site overnight, please speak to the show director. No one may park overnight at Seager Wheeler Farm without permission of the show director.

Directions to Seager Wheeler Farm:

If traveling on Hwy 12, turn East on Hwy 312 at Rosthern for 7km. There is a sign for the farm. Turn North on the grid road for ½ km and the farm is on the right.

Competitors: take the 3rd entrance (just past main entrance) and follow parking instructions.

Spectators: Use the main entrance.
