AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING SNOWMOBILE ROUTES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF MILLINGTON LIMITS

WHEREAS, during periods of snowfall, snowmobiles are used for transportation throughout the Village of Millington; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the safety and well-being of the citizens of the Village of Millington and for the persons using snowmobiles to designate a specific route for the use of snowmobiles traveling through the Village of Millington; and

WHEREAS, it is desirous to provide for a means of ingress and egress through the Village of Millington on a designated route, rather than through or over private property;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MILLINGTON:

SECTION 1: Use Regulations: Except as provided herein, a snowmobile must obey all Traffic Rules and Regulations as described in the Illinois Vehicle Code and Ordinances of the Village of Millington. A snowmobile shall have a functioning, manufacturer's approved muffler. A snowmobile may travel from their point of origin being the residence of owner or operator, in the most direct route to the following designated route without using private property. The following designated route is designated solely as an egress and ingress route allowing a snowmobile to pass through the Village of Millington. The following designated route may not be used for pleasure riding but merely for ingress and egress. The maximum speed allowed on the following designated route is 15 m.p.h. In the Village of Millington no snowmobile shall pull any object except an object designated for and properly attached to a snowmobile. A snowmobile shall be operated on the extreme right side of the roadway or roadway berm. A snowmobile shall be ridden with, and not against the ordinary flow of traffic. No snowmobile may operate past a church or funeral while any services are in progress. No snowmobile shall be operated in the Village of Millington between midnight and 6:00 A.M..

SECTION 2: Designated Routes: The designated route through the Village of Millington shall be from Bridge Street to Vine Street to Church Street, or any portion of the route.

SECTION 3: Emergency Exceptions: Not withstanding other provisions, a snowmobile may operate on any street in the Village of Millington when a snowmobile is the only form of vehicular traffic

that is capable of safe operation within Corporate limits of the Village of Millington. This exception may only be declared available by the Village President of the Village of Millington, the Kendall County Sheriff, the LaSalle County Sheriff, the Illinois State Police, or any official designated by any of these persons.

SECTION 4: Penalties: Any person found guilty of violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense.

This ordinance shall take effect and shall be in full force and effect ten days from and after its passage, approval, and publication or posting as required by law.
