THY KINGDOM COME 2021 PLAN TO PRAY THE SOUTH WEST COAST PATH



The Church of England in Devon is joining other churches in the county in an attempt to have people praying along every mile of the whole South West Coast path on the same day at the same time. The socially distant "chain of prayer and praise" on 19 June at 10.30 is being organised by South West Awake.

It is part of <u>Thy Kingdom Come</u>, when Christians across the world set aside the days between Ascension Day and Pentecost Sunday to pray for people to discover faith in God.

The Bishop of Exeter, the Right Reverend Robert Atwell, said "This is a fantastic initiative and opportunity for people from across the region to surround the South West in prayer.

"What a delight to praise God in places of such natural beauty and wonder and pray for this glorious peninsular of England."

The Diocese of Exeter is also re-opening its 24/7 Zoom Prayer Room after its success last year.

Over 500 people participated from across Devon and spectrum of church traditions.

A few churches took on a whole night or block during the 10 day period. One lady prayed for 10hour slots across the time.
