Quarterly Summit

Our Quarterly Summits are dynamic events, we draw 150+ attendees depending on venue, including both members and non-members. Non-members can attend for a \$25 fee, while WITCLT members receive two complimentary tickets through promotion codes. The event focuses on fostering community engagement and includes a variety of food and non-alcoholic beverages.

We collaborate with corporate partners and their Employee Resource Groups (ERGs) to showcase the strengths of both organizations. Sponsors at all levels—Silver, Gold, and Platinum—will have the opportunity to host a table at our Partner Showcase, which functions as a networking and exhibition space, similar to a tradeshow.

In addition, our summits feature our Girls+ in Tech program, where boys & girls (12-18 years old) break into groups for age-specific activities while our adult panel discussions take place. As a sponsor, you'll have the opportunity to select speakers and suggest relevant topics that align with the interests and needs of our diverse audience.

Networking Events

Our Networking Events are designed exclusively for casual, informal networking, providing a relaxed environment for meaningful connections. These events are hosted at Heist Brewery near Camp North End, with dates already secured for 8 out of the 12 months of 2025. We are also open to exploring other venue options based on the sponsor's preferences and needs.






