After 2 months of limited access, we are now open for routine eye exams. We must limit the number of patients allowed in the office in order to maintain the guidelines set forth by the national, state and local authorities. Unfortunately, we will have to take appointments only in order to control these numbers. We will be temporarily suspending our walk in policies for routine exams until concerns for COVID 19 have subsided. Emergencies may still walk in as needed. We will be taking all precautions to ensure our patients and staff are protected. We are requiring all patients to wear a face mask at all times in our office. Home-made masks are acceptable as long as the mask fully covers the nose and mouth. Temperatures and a COVID 19 survey will be taken for every patient. Due to occupancy restrictions, we ask that family members be left at home and anyone that arrives over 15 minutes late will need to reschedule.
