A hill was rented from Mr. Ed Thompson for a payment of \$5.

Since this hill was too small, the club decided to build a 40-foot high scaffold. This was built by club members. All of them actively participated in the work, and they did so with exceptional enthusiasm. As evidence of this, it can be mentioned that the scaffolding was completed by moonlight on the eve of January 5th.


Camrose, Jan. 24th, [19]12
