President & Founder of Justice Ministries



Mark Blackwell is the President and Founder of Justice Ministries, a non-profit organization committed to combating sex trafficking and sexual exploitation of women through providing outreach, emergency services and transitional care.

Mark is a Charlotte native. He was voted Mr. Myers Park by his classmates at Myers Park High School and graduated from UNC Wilmington where he served two terms as student body President.

In addition to his work in counter human trafficking, Mark has served with Samaritan's Purse in Iraq and the US southern border.

Justice Ministries was one of the first counter human trafficking organizations in the Carolinas. Justice Ministries is a partner agency serving on the Charlotte Metropolitan Human Trafficking Task Force.

Justice Ministries was highlighted on the National Geographic Channel for their outreach efforts to women trapped in sex slavery.

Regular Member: Membership in the WeROCC shall be open to any woman who is a registered Republican; or has the intent to register Republican and a resident of North Carolina, and who accepts and advocates the Objectives and Rules of this Organization.

Associate Members: Republican women who have primary membership in a federated local club are eligible for associate membership in local clubs upon payment of the required annual dues. Associate members cannot hold office, vote or be counted for the purpose of determining the number of delegates to national or state federation meetings or conventions. OR Republican men are eligible for associate membership upon payment of the required annual dues to the local club. They cannot hold office, have a voice or vote or be counted for the purpose of determining the number of delegates to national or state federation meetings or conventions. Republican men who are associate members in local clubs do not become members of the state federation of the NFRW.
