

## **Power Polishing**

#### Preamble:

The following information is intended only as a guide to better understand the various steps involved in paint correction and determine the level of service that suits your needs and budget.

#### **Baseline Scenario**

The chart below is intended to represent the <u>estimated</u> time and cost associated with each activity assuming the vehicle is a sedan/small SUV that is a daily driver and a few years old. The actual amount of time required to correct a vehicle using these steps will vary depending on the age, size, condition, type of paint and colour of vehicle (black and red vehicles commonly take a little longer to obtain quality results).

**Note**: Full restoration projects can take multiple days to achieve optimal results.

Paint Preparation				
Regular Wash	Remove surface dirt (shampoo/foam and pressure wash) and dry	0.5	50	25
Strip Wash	Apply degreaser to remove soap residue, existing waxes or sealants	0.5	50	25
Chemical Decontamination	Apply products to dissolve embedded particles (iron, brake dust) and rinse off	0.5	50	25
Mechanical Decontamination	Clay bar treatment (sap, tar, industrial fallout). Removes bonded contaminants and leaves a completely smooth panel improving multi-stage polishing and protection results.	1	50	50

Protect trim and badges	Tape off trim, weather stripping and badges	1	75	75
Wet Sanding (Colour Sanding)  Spot treatment only	Level paint, blend scratches/etching, remove heavy oxidation	1	75	75
