### COUNCIL MEETING OF THE FEDERATION : AMRITSAR(PUNJAB) ON 28.07.2022

The Council Meeting of All India State Bank of India Staff Federation was held on the 28<sup>th</sup> July 2022 at Amritsar(Punjab) to discuss the agenda items as per the Notice. The council meeting was chaired by Com.Arun Bhagoliwal, President.

Com.Iqbal Singh Malhi, President, State Bank of India Staff Association, Chandigarh Circle welcomed all Federation Executives and Council Members to the Meeting. Com.Malhi advised the house that this meeting is being held in Amritsar which is a Holy City having Golden Temple which is the highest seat of Sikh sect. Com.Malhi also gave reference to Jallianwala Bagh and Durgiana Temple which are a must visit places. Com.Malhi also advised that a Tour to Attari-Wagha Border has also been arranged by the Federation on 29.07.2022 from 3:00 P.M. onwards. After this Com.Iqbal Singh Malhi asked Comrade Arun Bhagoliwal, President, All India State Bank of India Staff Federation to start the meeting Agenda-wise.

Thereafter, the lamp lighting ceremony took place and all the Comrades present at the Dias viz.Com.Arun Bhagoliwal-President, Com.Sanjeev K. Bandlish-General Secretary, Com.Pradip K. Bahishy-Sr.Vice-President, Com.Jagdish D.Shringarpure-Sr.Vice-President and Com.G.Kripakaran lighted the lamp.

After this, Com.Arun Bhagoliwal welcomed all the members and asked the General Secretary to take up the agenda.

At the outset Com.Sanjeev Kumar Bandlish, General Secretary(AISBISF) welcomed all members of the Council to the meeting and advised them all that this meeting is of utmost importance as this meeting has been organised to finalise the Charter of Demand for the XIIth Bipartite Settlement which will be sent to National Confederation of Bank Employees for onward submission to United Forum of Bank Unions and UFBU will further submit the consolidated Charter of Demands to Indian Banks Association for negotiations.

Com.Bandlish elaborated various aspects in respect of some of the issues which have come up after Indore Conference viz.Single Transfer Policy, Sensitive Positions, Compassionate Appointment Scheme and Manpower Planning and Fresh Recruitment of 5000 clerical staff.

Com.Bandlish also read out the Minutes in detail in respect of recently held Central Bipartite Meeting with Corporate Centre Officials held at Kolkata on 13.07.2022.

Thereafter the issue of Inter-Circle Transfers/Inter-Module Transfers was discussed at length wherein all the General Secretaries of all the Circles participated and opined that Bank's not agreeing to ICT/IMT is a clear violation of agreement signed between the Bank and the Federation and suitable action should be taken for its implementation in true letter and spirit.

Com.Sanjeev Kumar Bandlish, General Secretary shared the complete details of Charter of Demands(COD) as prepared for the ensuing XIIIth Bipartite Wage Settlement. Few members of the Council participated in the discussions on the various items of COD which were duly taken up by the General Secretary, discussed and suitable replies were also given to the satisfaction of all. The entire house approved the Charter of Demand with one voice loudly and gave an applause.

The General Secretary also advised in detail the issue of merger of Public Sector Banks and the various steps taken by UFBU and postponement of the Strike dated 27.06.2022 at the instance of Chief Labour Commissioner(Central), New Delhi. Further, Com.Bandlish advised the house to be in preparedness for agitational programme as may be envisaged by UFBU on the pretext of listing of amendment to the Banking Laws in Parliament.

The house unanimously approved the accounts of the Federation with thunderous applause for the Calendar year 2021 and for the Financial year 2021-22.

The house unanimously co-opted the undernoted members in the Executive/Council of Federation to the interim vacancies arisen on account of retirements, creation of new modules etc. on the recommendations of Affiliate Circle Unions:


Thereafter, few members of Council were felicitated who were to retire by the end of July 2022 by presenting a shawl and a Memento.
