REVISION OF PAYMENT OF MINIMUM WAGES SWEEPERS/CASUAL LABOURERS/DAILY WAGERS

Government of India, Ministry of Labour and Employment, vide Ref.No.1/16(1)/2022-LS-II dated 28.09.2022 has revised the minimum wages payable to all persons engaged in employment of sweeping and cleaning etc. Accordingly, the minimum wages payable to all casual labourers/daily wagers engaged directly by the Bank or engaged through land-lord or the contractor for the Bank's work like sweeping/maintenance etc. effective from **01.10.2022** will be as under:

CITY TYPE	Effective from 01.10 .2022
'A' CENTRE Branches/Offices in Bangalore Urban Agglomeration area And 15 KMs radius from the periphery.	Rs.711/- per day
'B' CENTRE Branches/Offices in Mysore, Mangalore, Hubli-Dharwad, Belgaum and Kalaburagi Urban Agglomeration area and 15 KMs radius from the periphery.	Rs.595/- per day
'C' CENTRE All other areas not mentioned in (a) & (b) above	Rs.477/- per day

In this connection, HR Department, State Bank of India, Local Head Office, Bangalore is likely to issue the Circular shortly.

Members/Local Secretaries are requested to ensure strict compliance of the above instructions to such casual labourers wherever applicable.
