PAYMENT OF SALARY ARREARS OF 10TH AND 11TH BIPARTITE SETTLEMENT TO EX-SERVICEMEN COMRADES

Few of our Ex-servicemen Comrades who had filed Writ Petitions in the court against withdrawal of MSP component by the Bank, were not paid salary arrears of 10th and 11th Bipartite Settlement.

In one such case, the Hon'ble High Court of Allahabad has directed the Bank to release the payment of arrears by obtaining an Undertaking from the petitioners.

In view of the above, all our Ex-servicemen comrades, who are not in receipt of Salary arrears of either 10 th BPS or 11 th BPS or both, may furnish the Undertaking in the attached format and forward a copy to their respective controllers and CM, HRMS through Branch Manager, for release of arrears.

UNDERTAKING

I, _____ Son / Daughter of Shri _____, resident of _____, Pin- _____ and presently working as _____ (Designation) in (Department) at _____ (Location) have retired from Armed Forces / Defence Services on _____ and re-employed/joined State Bank of India in Ex-Servicemen category on _____.

2. I am aware that Bank had issued instructions regarding pay-fixation of Ex-servicemen re-employed in the Bank and as per the said guidelines the protection of the component of Military Service Pay (MSP) in re-fixation of pay in Banks has been excluded. I am one of the petitioners in the Writ Petition No _____ filed before the Hon'ble Court of _____ wherein the guidelines of the Bank regarding exclusion of MSP has been challenged. I am also aware that there are number of writ petitions pending before the Punjab and Haryana High Court/ different Courts, where the entitlement of the petitioners to receive their Military Service Pay is in issue.

3. Pending final outcome of such cases, wherein the entitlement of the petitioners to receive their Military Service Pay is in issue, I request State Bank of India to pay me arrears of wages as a consequence of revision in the pay-scales as per 10th / 11th Bipartite Settlements.

4. I hereby undertake to the State Bank of India that I would refund the proportionate benefits that I may receive, if the event in those petitions concerning the Military Service Pay goes against the Petitioners, subject of course to the final outcome of those petitions, including appeal etc. The Bank will also be otherwise entitled to recover the excess amount if any, which has been paid to me (i) from the balance standing to my credit of my account No. AND/OR (ii) recover Rs./- every month from my salary as decided by the Bank AND/OR (iii) as deemed fit by the Bank depending on actual circumstances.
