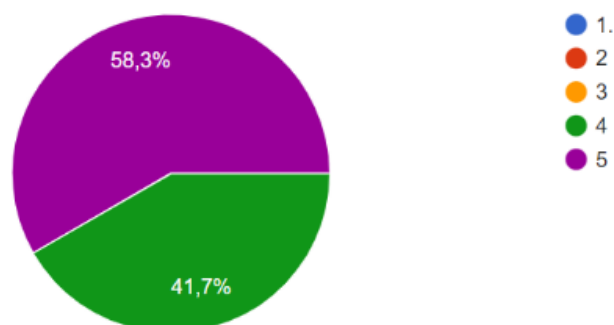


Evaluation of the Hungarian meeting

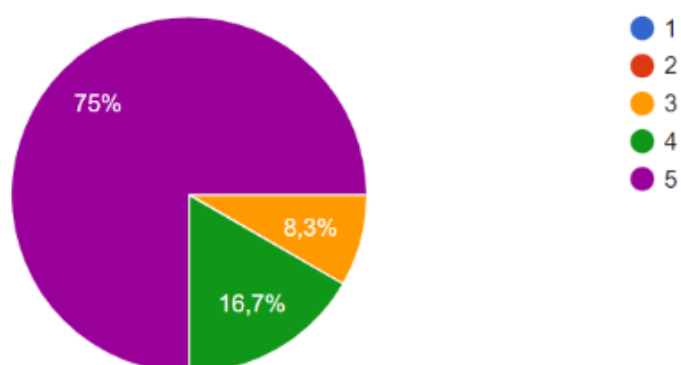


According to the attached figure, the participants were satisfied with the accommodation, 58.3% gave an excellent rating.

The following questions (2-12) refer to the implemented programs. From the answers of the participants, we can find out which programs the children liked the most, and what they thought about the organization.

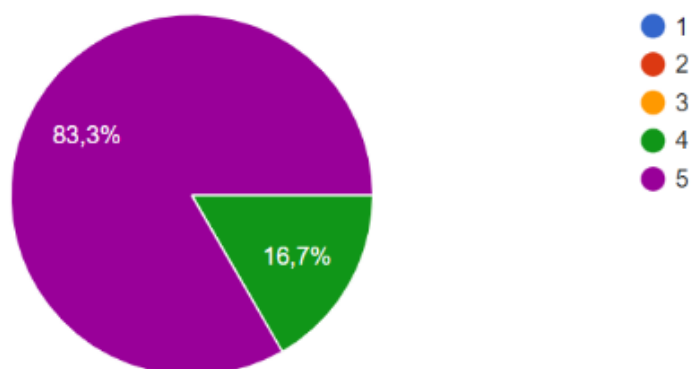
2. How did you like the program on Monday? (games at Felsőtárkány school, introduction and the welcome ceremony)

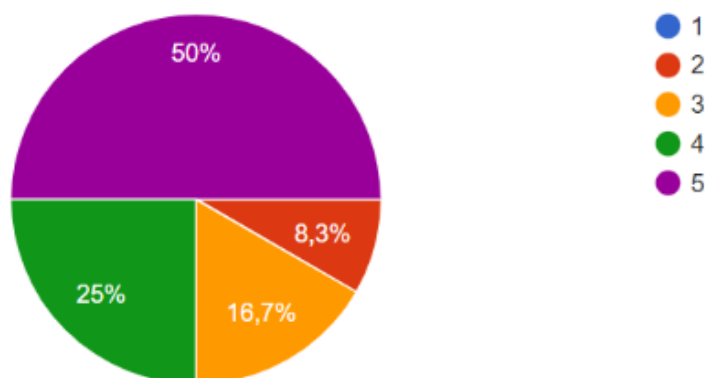
3. How did you like the sightseeing in Eger?

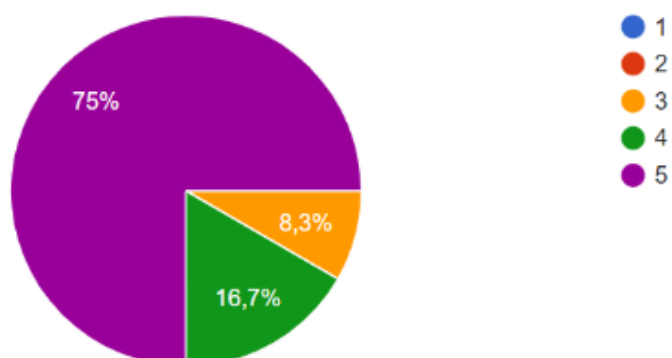
4. How did you like the cooperative activity of making a digital book in teams?

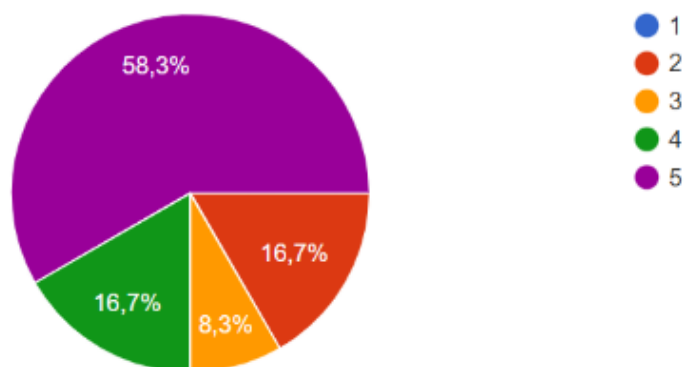
5. How did you feel about working in mixed groups?

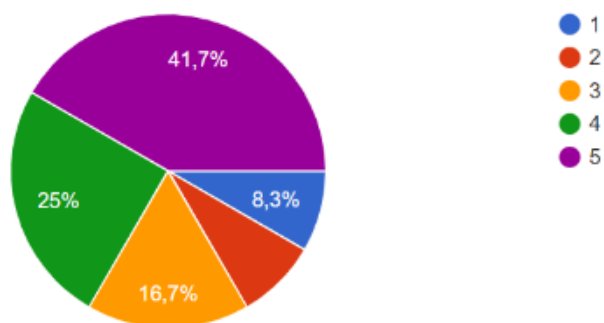
6. How did you like the horse riding?

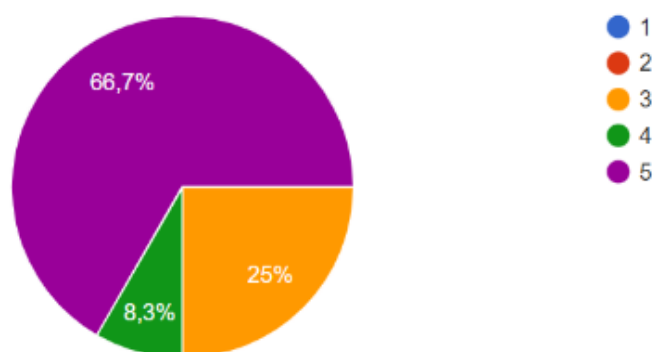
7. How did you like the wall climbing?

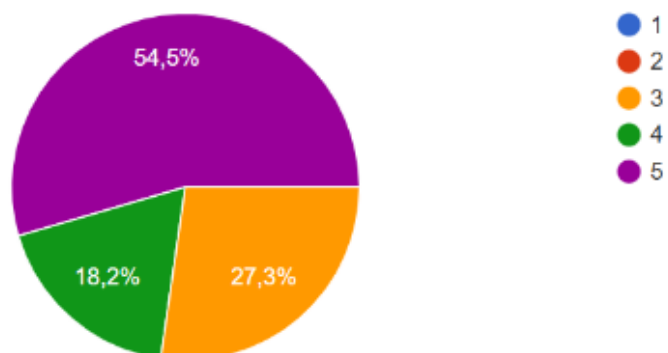
8. How did you like the orienteering?

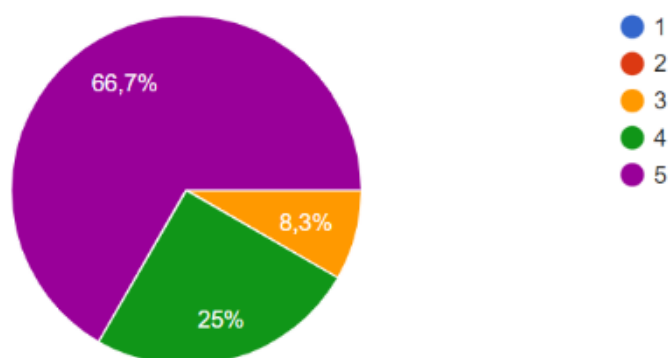
9. How did you like the archery?

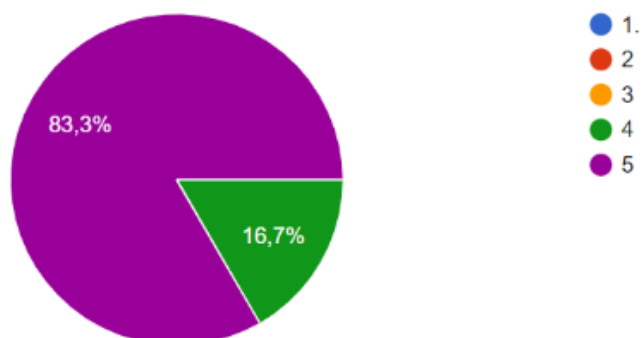
10. How did you like the laser target shooting?

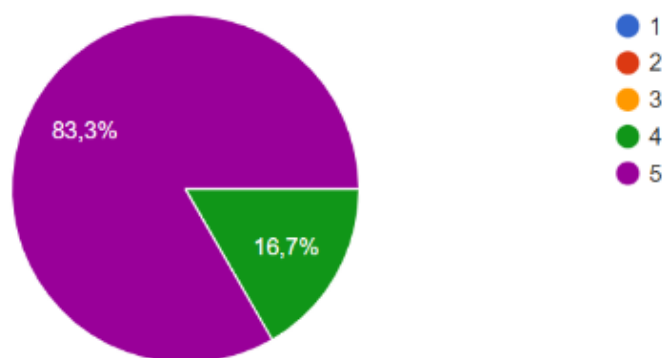
11. How did you like the trip to Budapest?

12. What do you think about the organization of the programs?

Among the programs, the children enjoyed the excursion and sightseeing the most, they really liked the history and sights of Eger and Budapest, and they were interested in Hungarian culture. 83.3% of respondents gave a grade of 5 and 16.7% a grade of 4. Most of them (75%) also enjoyed the welcome ceremony and ice breaker games at school on Monday. The least popular program was rock climbing. Although 41.7% of the participants rated this program as excellent, one participant gave it a grade of 1 and another two gave it a grade of 2.

50% of the respondents liked creating a digital book, however, many more (75%) said they enjoyed working in a mixed team.

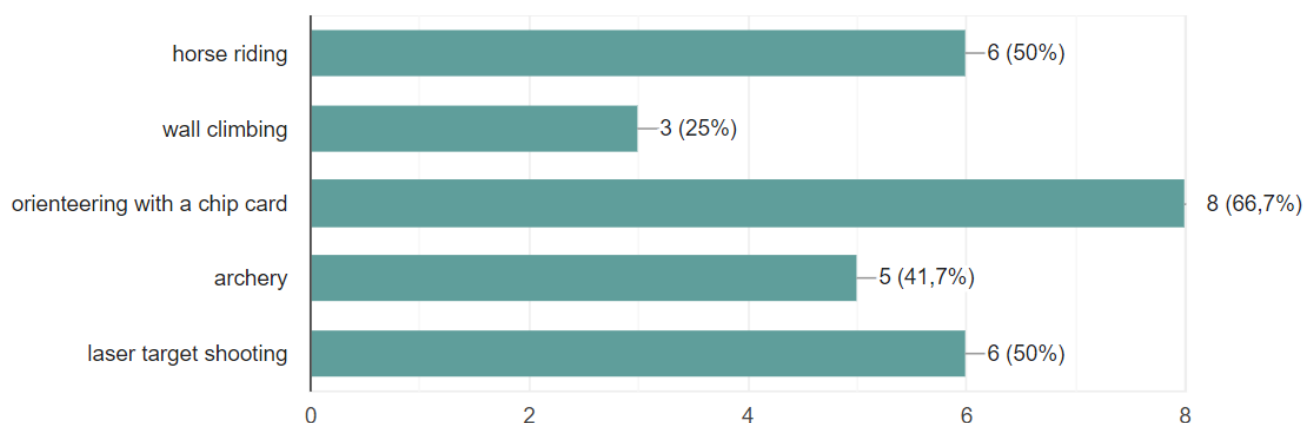
Among the sports tried during the program, laser shooting and orienteering were the favorites, 66.7% found both excellent. Laser shooting received 4 votes with 25% and chip card orienteering with 8.3%.

83.3% of the participants rated the organization as excellent.

Questions 13-15 examined the impact of the project on the participants:

13. Choose sports that you haven't tried before. You can choose more than one.

The graph clearly shows that each of the 6 sports presented at the Hungarian meeting was a new experience for one of the participants. Most of them were those who had never tried orienteering with a chip card (8 people), but horse riding and laser shooting were also new experiences for 50%.

14. Do you feel that your English has improved?

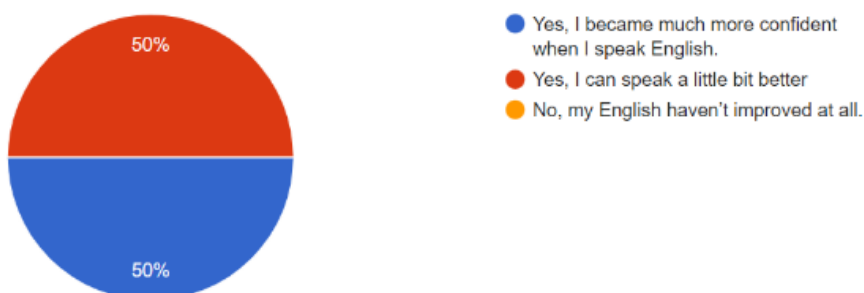


The project had a significant impact on the language skills of the participants. 50% feel much more confident, while the other 50% experienced improvement to a lesser extent, but definitely.

15. Have you managed to make friends with people from other countries?

According to the responses shown in the diagram, all participants made new friends from other countries. 58.3% feel that they have made a lot of new friends.
