### **MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT**

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) headline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

### **DIRECTIONS: 3 Wolverton Road Asbury, NJ 08802**

#### **FROM the East heading WEST on ROUTE 78:**

Route 78 WEST to EXIT 11, Route 173/West Portal. Off the exit, follow signs to stay on ROUTE 173 WEST; Continue for 2 miles and exit off Route 173 bearing right onto BRUNSWICK AVE. Make the right onto ASBURY/W PORTAL ROAD. Go 1/4 mile, make the first left onto VALLEY STATION ROAD. Cross over the green bridge (Valley Station turns into WOLVERTON Road). The entrance to The Ridge Farm @ Riverview is the first driveway on the left.

#### **FROM the East heading WEST (Truck Route)**

Route 78 West to exit 7, Rt 173 West, go approx. 1/2 mile, make first right (just past Musconetcong River) onto Bloomsbury Asbury Road. Go approx. 2.5 miles turn right onto Wolverton Road. Turn right on first driveway on right.

#### **FROM the West (PA) heading EAST on ROUTE 78**

Route 78 EAST to EXIT 6. This is the exit for the Weigh Station. Go to the end of the ramp and make a LEFT onto BLOOMSBURY ROAD. Continue about 2 1/2 miles (road becomes Asbury Bloomsbury Road) and make a RIGHT onto WOLVERTON ROAD. The Ridge Farm @ Riverview is the first driveway on the right.

# **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Pre-entries will be accepted until 12:00 noon two days before the show, after that post entry fees will apply.
2. Entries received after 12 noon 2 days before the show will be charged a \$25 post entry fee.
3. A \$65.00 office fee & \$25.00 EMT fee will be charged to all entries.
4. \$20 schooling fee automatically applied to all Hunter and Equitation entries.
5. A valid form of payment must be on file with the show office in order for back numbers to be issued. In addition to Checks, Credit Cards are accepted as payment; a 4% convenience fee will be assessed if this option is utilized.
6. A penalty of \$50.00 or 10% of total outstanding bill, whichever is greater will be charged for any non-negotiable checks or declined credit cards
7. All horses entering the show grounds must provide a current negative coggins and proof of current vaccines as outlined in GR845 of the USEF rulebook.
8. Prize money will be applied to show account. If additional prize money needs to be issued, it will be mailed within 30 days. In order for Prize Money to be awarded, Prize Money Payee information MUST be provided including name, address and social security or tax id number. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to provide this information on the entry blank. Incomplete or missing information will result in prize money not being issued. A Prize Money check is non-negotiable after 60 days and will be considered null and void and stop payment will be issued by the horse show's bank. A completed W-9 needs to be on file with show management.
9. ASTM/SEI certified headgear is required at all times when mounted.
10. The Ridge Farm, The Ridge South LLC, its employees or owners, Nona Garson, George D'Ambrosio, or any member of the show staff/committee will not be held responsible for any accident, loss, theft or damage at the show. It shall be the condition of every exhibitor to hold the same blameless or harmless for any accident or loss.
11. The committee reserves the right to cancel/combine/substitute classes at their discretion.
12. Schooling will be permitted only in areas provided by the committee. Back numbers must be issued and worn.
13. Hunter courses may be judged on performance, soundness, and manners. They may include gates, coops, walls, brushes, oxers, panels and combinations.
14. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rulebook and USHJA Zone 2 specifications, as applicable will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
15. A jump order will be established at the in gate with the starter.
16. Ties other than first, will remain tied.
17. Sharps containers will be located in the secretary stand.
18. All entries not paid at the horse show will incur a \$100 late payment fee.
19. All pets must be kept on a leash at all times.
20. All Classes are \$30, Marshall & Sterling \$45.00.

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. ## **Motor Vehicle Statement**

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. 

Open to Adult Amateur riders on horses. To be run as a two-round classic. Round one may be a designated over-fences class from the regular division. Classic can be run separately or combined with Children's Hunter Horses and/or Ponies.

#### **202. Bit O'Straw Hunter Classic 2'6**

Open to Junior or Amateur riders. No cross entry of horse/pony or rider into The League's Children's Horse, Pony or Adult Hunter Classic. No cross entry of rider into any rated Hunters or any class with fences of 3' or higher.

#### **203. \$250.00 Low Children's Hunter Classic 2'6**

May be offered as a One-Round, Two-Round, or Two-Round Classic with a designated first round. Open to Junior riders on horses or ponies. No cross-entry of rider into any Rated Hunter section. No cross-entry of horse/rider combination into any classes where fences exceed 2'9".

#### **204. \$250.00 Low Adult Hunter Classic 2'6**

May be offered as a One-Round, Two-Round, or Two-Round Classic with a designated first round. Open to Amateur riders on horses or ponies. No cross-entry of rider into any Rated Hunter section. No cross-entry of horse/rider combination into any classes where fences exceed 2'9".

#### **205. Pre-Child/Adult Hunter Classic 2'**

Open to Junior and Amateur Riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not cross into any USEF rated Hunter Divisions. Exception: Low/Novice Child/Adult Hunter. No cross entry of horse or rider into any section with fence heights exceeding 2'6".

May be combined with Child Horse and/or Pony Medal.

#### **207. Children's Medal 3'-Sponsored by Pyranha**

Open to Junior Riders on horses that are not competing in any Hunter or Equitation class in which the fences exceed 3'3". To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at 3' including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course for points to count. No cross-entry of rider into the Children's Pony Medal at the same show. May be combined with Adult 3' and/or Pony Medal.

#### **208. Low Adult Medal 2'6**

Open to Adult Amateur Riders who are not competing at the same show in any class with fences exceeding 3'. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at 2'6" including at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course for points to count. May ONLY be combined with The League Children's 2'6" Medal.

#### **209. Low Children's Medal 2'6**

Open to Junior Riders on horses or ponies that are not competing at the same show in any class with fences exceeding 3'. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at the required height including at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course for points to count. No cross-entry of rider into The League Children's Pony Medal at the same show. May ONLY be combined with The League Adult 2'6" Medal.

### 210. Children's Pony Medal (Lg. Pony 2'6, Sm & Med 2')

Open to Junior Riders on ponies that are not competing at the same show in any class with fences at 3' or higher. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at the required height with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. A combination is optional and must be adjusted according to fence heights. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same pony must be used in all phases. Only one rider per pony. (Riders may not ride in more than one height section of the class.) Three riders must complete the course for points to count. No cross-entry of rider into the Pyranha™ Children's Horse Medal or Children's 2'6" Medal at the same show. May be combined with The League Children's Horse Medal and/or The League Adult Medal.

### 211. Pre-Child/Adult Medal 2'

Open to Junior and Amateur riders on horses or ponies who are eligible to compete in the Pre-Child/Adult Hunters. No cross entry of rider into any other class with fence heights of 2'6" or higher. The same horse/pony must be used in all phases. Ponies may not cross-enter into the League Pony Medal sections.
