## RULES AND REGULATIONS ENTRIES

1. Pre-entries will be accepted until 48 hours before the show. Entries received after this time will be accepted and charged a \$25 post entry fee.

2. Numbers: No numbers will be given out without full payment of all fees being secured, all required signatures, valid phone number, & all other required information on the entry form must be completed in full.

## FEES

3. All Exhibitors showing will be charged \$50.00 EMT fee, a \$70.00 office fee.

4. Class Fees shall be \$50 for all classes and warm up classes, unless otherwise specified.

## PAYMENT

5. **All entries not paid** at the horse show will be considered late and will incur a \$50.00 late payment fee.

6. A **\$100.00** fee will be charged for any non-negotiable funds, from checks or credit cards. (\*debit cards not accepted). A **4% credit card convenience fee** will be added to the amount due.

7. **Refunds:** Entries canceled prior to the closing date of entries will be refunded in full. Stalls and processing fee are not refundable.

8. **All scratches** must be submitted in writing to be considered for a refund. Horses scratched the day of the show will be subject to a \$25.00 scratch fee. If the show must be stopped due to storm, accident, or other emergency, show management has the right to deny a refund of any fees.

9. **All riders** must always wear proper attire and safety Certified ASTM protective head gear while mounted.

10. **Schooling** will be permitted only in designated areas provided by the committee and scheduled as time permits. Back numbers must be issued and worn.

11. A **jump order** will be established at the in-gate with the starter.

12. **All pets** must always be kept on a leash.

13. **Sharps containers** will be located in the secretary stand.

14. **Every class** offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

15. **Classes** will be run in accordance with all leagues/organizations governing each class as listed in the class title.

16. **Stalls, if available**, will be 10'x 10' temporary stalls with doors and a dirt floor. **DRY STALL** Weekend Show special ( Fri-Sun) \$200, or \$150 per day. Stabling fees subject to Florida sales tax. Please contact : [entry@ridgeshowjumping.com](mailto:entry@ridgeshowjumping.com) prior to arrival to make arrangements. You will be required to bring your own ,hay ,grain ,shavings and water buckets. You will be required to clean stall daily and strip stall before you leave. A \$100.00 fee will be assessed for any stall not cleaned or stripped completely.

17. **A current negative Coggins and proof of EHV vaccine** will be required for all horses entering the show grounds.
18. **All Hunter classes** will be judged on performance and soundness with an emphasis on soundness and manners.

### **Prize Money**

19. Prize money will be applied to the show account balance first. In order for the prize money to be awarded, Prize money payee information must be provided, including name, address, and taxpayer identification number. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to provide this information on the entry blank. Each season a new W-9( for the current season) must be filled out and on file with the show office.
20. If additional Prize Money is left, it will be issued and will be mailed within 30 days using the information provided. A completed W9 is required to be on file with show management (for each current season). It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to provide this information on all entry blanks .Incomplete or missing information will result in money not being issued.\* **All Prize Money checks are Non-negotiable after 60 days from the date of issue.**

### **Management**

21. The Committee/Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, change, move, or add classes or substitute classes or schooling as deemed necessary and at their full discretion. Management has ultimate say in all disputes.
22. The Ridge Farm LLC, The Ridge South LLC, its employees or owners, Nona Garson, George D'Ambrosio, or any member of the show committee will not be held responsible for any accident, loss, theft, or damage at the show. It shall be the condition of every exhibitor to hold the same blameless or harmless for any accident or loss.

Class 800 : "RIDE FOR THE CURE" GAMBLER'S CHOICE All proceeds donated directly to the Breast Cancer Research Foundation. Have fun with our signature class joining our day of equestrian sport & generosity! How many jumps can you do in 60 seconds?! How much money can you raise to fight Breast cancer?! Riders in this special class will submit a "Pledge Card" on which they will list sponsors for their performance. Each sponsor on the list will have pledged a particular dollar amount per jump that is done within the time allowed, over a course of fences designed by the rider. Each sponsor's total donation to the fight against breast cancer will be determined by how many jumps the rider can jump in the allotted time. Pledge cards available in advance on our website ([www.ridgeshowjumping.com](http://www.ridgeshowjumping.com)), or on the show day at the office. Sponsor attire permitted, costumes, too! Bring out the Pink! At the end of the 60 second tone sound rider has option to jump jokers fence. If Joker jumps clean ,pledge is doubled. 10 points awarded for every jump clear. 100 points for clearing the joker

\* Class will start at 18" and go up from there as necessary for all to participate, please declare height on entry blank. \* Each competitor has 60 seconds to jump all the obstacles he wishes in any order. \* An audible signal declares start and the finish of the round. \* Obstacles will be built to be jumped in either direction. \* Each obstacle may be jumped only twice. \* A competitor will be credited for each obstacle jumped correctly. \* No credit is awarded for an obstacle knocked down. If the fixed time is reached at the moment when the horse is already taking off (front hooves off the ground), this obstacle counts if it is correctly jumped. \* All disobediences are penalized by the time lost by the competitor. The competitor must withdraw after a fall. Nevertheless the rider scores the pledge obtained up to the moment of his or her fall. \* One designated obstacle will be provided in the course duly marked by flags and titled "DOUBLE YOUR PLEDGE". This jump is an optional jump, chosen by the rider as to whether to take the opportunity to attempt to clear the obstacle, thereby doubling the total amount pledged. The sponsor has the option to accept or decline the challenge to double their pledge. This jump must be attempted within 60 seconds of the finishing signal of the first round. This option of accepting or declining the doubling of the pledge should be written in advance on the pledge card. Should a sponsor not wish to "gamble" a pledged amount, a capped donation will of course be accepted and appreciated. \* Checks will be written to The Breast Cancer Research Foundation, and are considered a fully tax-deductible 501(C)3 donation. ## \$1000 HUNTER DERBY

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to horses ridden by Juniors, Amateurs or Professionals. Riders are not limited to the number of horses they may ride. Horses and riders may cross enter into any division for which they are otherwise eligible.

**JUDGING:** To be scored under the open numerical judging system. The top 12 will return for the second round in reverse order of their scores if time allows scores will be added to determine the winners. In the case of a tie, judges will confer to break the tie. Management reserves the right to change the class format of the class to a Hunt N'Go due to number of entries or weather conditions.

**COURSE REQUIREMENTS:** First Round: To be shown over a hunter classic type course of . Fences to simulate those found in hunting country, including natural post and rail, stone wall, white board fence, coop, hedge, brush, logs and natural foliage. To be judged on performance, hunter pace and style, quality, substance and movement. After the judge's preliminary scores are given, one bonus point will be awarded for each high option chosen. Second Round: To be shown over a hunter handy type course of at least 8 fences. To include elements such as roll-backs, tight turn options, trot jumps, hand gallop, halt and/or back, or work through a gate while mounted. To be judged on performance, hunter pace, style, quality, substance and movement, handiness and brilliance of pace. Handiness is defined as ground saving movement without adversely affecting performance or style. Brilliance of pace is defined as a faster pace than ordinary, without sacrificing performance or style. Formal attire requested but not required.
