

DIRECTIONS: 3 Wolverton Road Asbury, NJ 08802 FROM the East heading WEST on ROUTE 78:

Route 78 WEST to EXIT 11, Route 173/West Portal. Off the exit, follow signs to stay on ROUTE 173 WEST; Continue for 2 miles and exit off Route 173 bearing right onto BRUNSWICK AVE. Make the right onto ASBURY/W PORTAL ROAD. Go 1/4 mile, make the first left onto VALLEY STATION ROAD. Cross over the green bridge (Valley Station turns into WOLVERTON Road). The entrance to The Ridge Farm @ Riverview is the first driveway on the left.

FROM the East heading WEST (Truck Route)

Route 78 West to exit 7, Rt 173 West, go approx. ½ mile, make first right (just past Musconetcong River) onto Bloomsbury Asbury Road. Go approx. 2.5 miles turn right onto Wolverton Road. Turn right on first driveway on right.

FROM the West (PA) heading EAST on ROUTE 78

Route 78 EAST to EXIT 6. This is the exit for the Weigh Station. Go to the end of the ramp and make a LEFT onto BL OOMSBURY ROAD. Continue about 2 ½ miles (road becomes Asbury Bloomsbury Road) and make a RIG HT onto WOLVERTON ROAD. The Ridge Farm @ Riverview is the first driveway on the right.

Rules & Regulations

All Classes \$30 Except Marshall & Sterling, those classes are \$40 Post entries will be accepted after 12 noon the day before the show with a \$25 post entry fee

- There will be a \$50 Office/EMT/Grounds Fee charged to all entries. Horses scratched on the day of the show will be charged a \$25 scratch fee.
- A current negative coggins and proof of EHV vaccine will be required for all horses entering the show grounds.
- Schooling will be permitted only in designated areas. Back numbers must be issued and worn. 10 Minute course Walks will be offered with each Jump Height Change
- All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with an emphasis on soundness and manners.
- Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, change or add classes or schooling as
- deemed necessary.
 - ASTM/SEI certified headgear is required at all times when mounted on the show grounds.
- All pets must be leashed.
 - All fees must be secured and entry forms complete, including required signatures, before a number can be issued for any horse.
- It is a condition of entry to the showgrounds that these rules and regulations are read, understood and accepted.
 - A \$75 fee will be charged for any non-negotiable checks.
- Credit cards will be accepted for payment but please note that a 4% convenience fee will be added to the amount due.
- In order for Prize Money to be awarded, Prize Money payee information Must be provided, including name, address, and tax-payer identification number. It is the sole
- responsibility of the exhibitor to provide this information on the entry blank. Prize Money will be applied to show accounts. If additional Prize Money needs to be issued, it will be mailed withing 30 days using the information provided on the entry blank provided a completed W9 is on file with show management. All Prize Money checks are non-negotiable after 60 days from the date of issue.

The Ridge South, LLC, its employees or owners, Nona Garson, George D'Ambrosio, or any member of the show committee will not be held responsible for any accident, loss, theft or damage at the show. It shall be the condition of every exhibitor to hold the same blameless for any accident or loss.

Every effort has been made to avoid errors in this publication. The Ridge South, LLC, Nona Garson, George D'Ambrosio or any member of the show committee assume no liability for errors. Any changes will be disclosed to the competitors upon entry. Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in these rules. the same shall be referred to show management whose decision shall be final.

200. Children's Hunter Classic (Horses 3', Ponies Lg. 2'6, Sm/Med 2')

Open to Junior riders on horses. To be run as a two-round classic. Round one may be a designated over-fences class from the regular division. Classic can be run separately or combined with Ponies and/or Adult Hunters. Fences 3'

201. Adult Hunter Classic 3'

Open to Adult Amateur riders on horses. To be run as a two-round classic. Round one may be a designated over-fences class from the regular division. Classic can be run separately or combined with Children's Hunter Horses and/or Ponies.

202. Bit O'Straw Hunter Classic 2'6

Open to Junior or Amateur riders. No cross entry of horse/pony or rider into The League's Children's Horse, Pony or Adult Hunter Classic. No cross entry of rider into any rated Hunters or any class with fences of 3' or higher.

203. Low Children's Hunter Classic 2'6

May be offered as a One-Round, Two-Round, or Two-Round Classic with a designated first round. Open to Junior riders on horses or ponies. No cross-entry of rider into any Rated Hunter section. No cross-entry of horse/rider combination into any classes where fences exceed 2'9".

204. Low Adult Hunter Classic 2'6

May be offered as a One-Round, Two-Round, or Two-Round Classic with a designated first round. Open to Amateur riders on horses or ponies. No cross-entry of rider into any Rated Hunter section. No cross-entry of horse/rider combination into any classes where fences exceed 2'9".

205. Pre-Child/Adult Hunter Classic 2'

Open to Junior and Amateur Riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not cross into any USEF rated Hunter Divisions. Exception: Low/Novice Child/Adult Hunter. No cross entry of horse or rider into any section with fence heights exceeding 2'6".

206. Adult Medal 3'- Sponsored by Dover Saddlery

Open to Adult Amateur Riders. To be shown over minimum of 8 fences at 3' including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course for points to count. May be combined with Child Horse and/or Pony Medal.

207. Children's Medal 3'-Sponsored by Pyranha

Open to Junior Riders on horses that are not competing in any Hunter or Equitation class in which the fences exceed 3'3". To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at 3' including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course for points to count. No cross-entry of rider into the Children's Pony Medal at the same show. May be combined with Adult 3' and/or Pony Medal.

208. Low Adult Medal 2'6

Open to Adult Amateur Riders who are not competing at the same show in any class with fences exceeding 3'. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at 2'6" including at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course for points to count. May ONLY be combined with The League Children's 2'6" Medal.

209. Low Children's Medal 2'6

Open to Junior Riders on horses or ponies that are not competing at the same show in any class with fences exceeding 3'. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at the required height including at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course for points to count. No cross-entry of rider into The League Children's Pony Medal at the same show. May ONLY be combined with The League Adult 2'6" Medal.







Equitation Continued

210. Children's Pony Medal (Lg. Pony 2'6, Sm & Med 2')

Open to Junior Riders on ponies that are not competing at the same show in any class with fences at 3' or higher. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at the required height with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. A combination is optional and must be adjusted according to fence heights. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same pony must be used in all phases. Only one rider per pony. (Riders may not ride in more than one height section of the class.) Three riders must complete the course for points to count. No cross-entry of rider into the PyranhaTM Children's Horse Medal or Children's 2'6" Medal at the same show. May be combined with The League Children's Horse Medal and/or The League AdultMedal.

211. Pre-Child/Adult Medal 2'

Open to Junior and Amateur riders on horses or ponies who are eligible to compete in the Pre-Child/Adult Hunters. No cross entry of rider into any other class with fence heights of 2'6" or higher. The same horse/pony must be used in all phases. Ponies may not cross-enter into the League Pony Medal sections.

220. Itty Bitty Jumper Classic

Jumps not to exceed 0.65m. Open to all horses and ponies, Junior and Amateur riders. Courses will not include oxers or combinations. Prior to competing in Itty Bitty Jumper, riders may not cross entry into classes exceeding 2'6" (.76m) in height at the same competition.

221, 222, 223. Tri Level Pony Jumper Classics

Open to Small, Medium and Large ponies with fence heights to be as follows: Small .70m, Medium .80m and Large .90m. Ponies may not cross enter into Itty Bitty Jumper Classic.

224. Intermediate Junior/Adult .80m Jumper Classic

Horse/Rider combination must have entered in at least one other jumper class at the show and may not show in any class with fences 1.0m or higher. Table II.2.a/b. 0.80m.

225. Junior/Adult .90m Jumper Classic

Fences .90m - Open to Junior or Amateur Adult riders. The horse must have shown in at least one other Jumper Class at the same show. Horse/Rider combination may only compete in one Jumper Classic at the same show.

226. Low Junior/Adult Jumber Classic 1.0 M

Fences 1.0m - 1.05m - Open to Junior or Adult Amateur riders. The horse must have shown in at least one other Jumper Class at the same show. The horse/rider combination may compete in one Jumper Classic at the same show. No cross-entry into the 1.15m or .90m Jumpers at the same show.

227. High Junior/Adult Jumper Classic 1.10 M

Fences 1.10m – 1.15m - Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders. The horse must have entered at least one other Jumper class at the same show. The horse/rider combination may compete in one Jumper Classic at the same show. No cross entry into the 1.05m or the .90m Jumpers.
