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RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRIES/PAYMENTS/FEES

1. **Pre-entries** will be accepted until 9:00am the day before the start of each show. All other entries submitted after that point will be accepted and charged a \$50.00 post entry fee if received after the pre-entry deadline.

2. **Numbers**: No numbers will be given out without **A SIGNED OPEN CHECK** or **Credit card Authorization form**. All required signatures, valid phone number, address, USEF/USHJA numbers and all other required information on the entry form must be completed in full. Open check or credit card must be on file for each new season/year.

3. All Exhibitors showing will be charged \$50.00 EMT fee, a \$80.00 office fee, and \$5.00 USHJA & Outreach fee per horse. *USEF fee of \$23.00 for drug and admin will be collected. Standard USEF fees will apply. A 4% credit card convenience fee will be added to all entries paid by credit card. * (No Amex or debit cards accepted)

4. **Class Fees** shall be \$55.00/Equitation and Classics \$65.00, \$40/Hunter and Warm up classes, M& S Sterling classes \$55.00, WEC Cup \$75.00, Hunter Breeding \$55.00, Jumper classes are \$50.00, unless otherwise specified amount in the body of the prize list. All Nomination and class entry fees are indicated with class description. All other entry fees and nomination fees are listed in each prize list (*Please read and ask the office prior to the start of each show if you have questions about fees each prize list can vary)

5. **All entries not paid** at the horse show within 24 hours will be considered late and will incur a \$50.00 late payment fee. Office staff will close out open invoices by the payment method being held by entry. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to review each open invoice/bill and dispute at the end of each show or the bill stands without further review.

6. A fine of \$100.00 plus collection fees will be charged for any non-negotiable funds, from checks or credit cards.(*debit cards not accepted). This includes all credit cards that are declined. A 4% credit card convenience fee will be added to all entries paid by credit card.

7. **Refunds:** Entries canceled prior to the closing date of entries will be refunded in full. Stabling, nominating administration and credit card and processing fee are not refundable under any circumstances .Prior to the start of the competition you may scratch a horse from the show. Please send to the show secretary in writing at, <u>Entry@ridgeshowjumping.com</u>. Any entry fees will be refunded less a \$150.00 fee will be imposed. We encourage you to check your show bill at the end of each show. Theridge.horsespot.net or stop by the office.

8. **All scratches** must be submitted in writing to be considered for a refund. Horses scratched the day of the show will be subject to a \$25.00 scratch fee. If the show must be stopped due to storm, accident, or other emergency, show management has the right to deny a refund of any fees.

9. **Stalls, if available**, will be 10'x 12' temporary stalls with doors and matted dirt floors. DRY STALL \$400 weekly if available, or \$100 per day. Stabling fees subject to Florida sales tax. Please contact :

<u>entry@ridgeshowjumping.com</u>, prior to arrival to make arrangements. You will be required to bring your own hay, grain, shavings and buckets. You will be required to clean stalls daily and strip stall before you leave. A\$75.00 fee will be assessed for any stall not cleaned or stripped properly.

MISCELLANEOUS

10. All riders/participants must always wear proper attire and safety **Certified ASTM** protective head gear while mounted on show grounds. Any participant will be asked to leave the ring or class or show immediately. Rule listed USEF under GR801.

11. **Schooling** will be permitted only in designated areas provided by the committee and scheduled as time permits. Back numbers must be issued and worn at all times.

12. A jump order will be established at the in-gate with the starter.

13. All pets/ dogs must always be kept on a leash. (compliant GR1301.6)

14. Sharps containers will be located in the secretary stand and in the stables.

15. A current negative Coggins and proof of EHV vaccine will be required for all horses entering the show grounds.

16. **All Marshall & Sterling** designated classes will be run in accordance with M& S specifications and regulations.

17. All Hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with an emphasis on soundness and manners.

18. **All recognized Hunter obstacles classes as per rule HU118.3** will use option A, for all horses being considered for an award, which reads: Horses/Ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fence performance. Horses/Ponies ,y be asked to return to the ring and trot another circle at the judges' discretion.

19. **Every class** offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith, and in accordance with Zone 4 Rules. 20. **Classes** will be run in accordance with all leagues/organizations governing each class as listed in the class title.

22. All participants, owners, riders, farms, trainers, coach, must be in good standing with USHJA and USEF. Parents must take4 safe sport and be a full member if signing for under aged minors. All must be registered and safe sport compliant/completed prior to the Show Start Date. It is the responsibility of the participant to make sure prior to the Show start that they are eligible to show. Failure to do so will result in MANAGEMENT NOT ALLOWING YOU TO SHOW. NO ACCEPTIONS ! (*If asked ,be prepared to show proof you have recently done this, to the show secretary) For more details .See MAAP safe sport rules and regs online with USEF.

21. All horses must be Microchipped and registered with UESF /USHJA and on file with the federations. It must be provided and done prior to coming to the licensed competition. It is the sole responsibility of the participants to do this. HU1031, EQ103.2 and JP 100.2. A microchip must be 15 digits ISO compliant 11784/11785 and chip be implanted in the nuchal ligament of the animal. Failure to have all correct USEF/ USHJA numbers and updated registrations, safe sport ,microchip you will be ineligibile to compete .You could incur show fees, Federation fees and further charges /expense may occur. Points may not be counted or recorded.

22. **Horse/Pony measurements** will be made by appointment only. You must make arrangements with the show office by Saturday at noon prior to the start of the show date start. On recognized show dates only in the month of January . You will need prior approval from the steward on duty and the Veterinarian on call. The office will set that up for you. You will pay all the show fees of the show that day ,plus a class fee. An additional fee will be paid directly to the Veterinarian that day and payment arrangements will be set up with them for that fee only.

23 . PRIZE MONEY

In order for the prize money to be awarded, Prize money payee information must be provided, including name, address, and taxpayer identification number. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to provide this information on the entry blank. Each season a new W-9(for the current season) must be filled out and on file with the show office. If there are fewer than 18 entries in a class offering \$1,000 or more in prize money, the class will be held as a sweepstakes with the entry fees

combined to make the purse. If there are fewer than 6 entries, a class offering \$3,000 or more in Prize Money the class will not run .Money will be paid as follows

1st,-30%,2nd -22%,3rd-18%,4th-10%.5th-10%,6th-10%

24. Prize Money will be applied to the show accounts balance first. If additional Prize Money is left, it will be issued and will be mailed within 30 days using the information provided. A completed W9 is required to be on file with show management. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to provide this information on all entry blanks .Incomplete or missing information will result in money not being issued.* All Prize Money checks are Non-negotiable after 60 days from the date of issue.

MANAGEMENT

25. The Committee/Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, change, move, or add classes or substitute classes or schooling as deemed necessary and at their full discretion. Management has ultimate say in all disputes. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and return any fees paid prior to the start of the show without financial obligation or liability. The Committee further has the authority to remove and or refuse anyone or any horse from the show grounds.

26. **The Ridge Farm LLC, The Ridge South LLC, The Ridge Grand Prix Tour Group LLC**, its employees or owners, Nona Garson, George D'Ambrosio, or any member of the show

committee will not be held responsible for any accident, loss, theft, or damage at the show. It shall be the condition of every exhibitor and person on the property to hold the same blameless or harmless for any accident or loss.

27. Equine Zero Liability Florida State Senate Bill 1658. Under Florida Law Equines Zero Liability Statue:
Warning under Florida Law an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities.
28. Every effort has been made to avoid errors in this publication. The Ridge South LLC, The Grand Prix Tour Group, Nona Garson, George D'Ambrosio or any member of the show committee assume no liability for errors. Any changes will be disclosed to the competitors upon entry. Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in these rules, the same shall be referred to show management whose decision shall be final.

29. It is a condition of entry to the showgrounds that these rules and regulations are read, understood, and accepted.

Motorized Vehicle Statement

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management is their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to Segway, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/ legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individual as with disabilities are exempt from this rule is are exempt from this rule.


Membership Statement:

At any licensed competition event: USEF: All riders, owners, horses, farms, trainer, coach, must have their membership paid and be up to date prior to show start date. All safe Sport must be up to date. You must be a member in good standing to show. Failure to do so will result in management not allowing you to compete. NO ACCEPTIONS.

Farm Owners: If a horse is recorded as owned by a Farm or Business, at least one of the owners of the Recorded Farm of Business must be a Federation Senior Active Competing Member in good standing. Updates have been made to the USEF. \Box Note: Equestrian Canada farm owners will also need to obtain a USEF competing membership and complete Safe Sport Training. If they do not wish to earn points, they may use their Equestrian Canada number to obtain this membership for free. Farm Accounts: Farm/ Business account ownership can now be managed through member accounts online.


USEF Show Passes must be completed online. \Box Be aware that competitions are not permitted to collect paper applications and fees for Show Passes. \Box **Entry Blank:** Additionally, every entry blank must have a trainer's signature. Trainers are required to be active competing members of USEF. This includes guardians who sign for minors. Entry Blank and Waiver Signatures: All entries, for all competitions must have a properly signed entry blank as well as a waiver/release agreement from each participant at the competition. Trainers or coaches, or parents or guardians must have safe sport. * See USEF Rules, regulations, and guidelines.

USHJA: A rider, owner, horse, farm, trainer, coach, must be in good standing, registered and paid up to date. Failure to do so will result in a show pass fee charge of \$45.00 on your entry. **NO EXCEPTIONS and no refunds.**



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



Membership Statement:

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7)assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

Safe Sport Reminder:

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. Motorized Vehicle Statement:

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle of vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
